When our former ministry IBL-VN was terminated last month there were unfinished tasks and one of them was to save two classes of Pastoral Training from abandonment: The first class is almost done and the second class is just on half way of the training. This class would have finished their study and graduated two years ago without prevention from Cv.19 Pandemic. The final course that needs to be resumed is Hamartiology, the study of sin in the human race. This is one out of twelve courses in the Three Year Pastoral Training Curriculum, a training curriculum for Pastors and Church Leaders that involves Basic Theology (five courses), Basic Ministry Skills (four courses), and Basic Biblical Leadership Principles (two courses).

The course we're going to teach in July will take one week to study. If the Lord is willing we will start it on Monday 11Jul2022 and will conclude it on Friday 15Jul2022. To cover expenses for traveling, lodging, and meals for these dear folks we need \$2,500. We also need \$500 for miscellaneous spending for the Final Graduation and this makes the fund needed for that week \$3,000.
