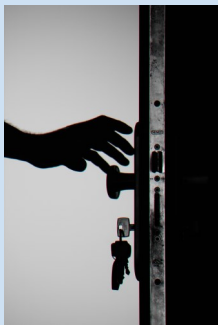


4 Truths from God About Prayer

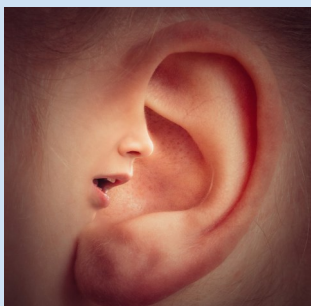
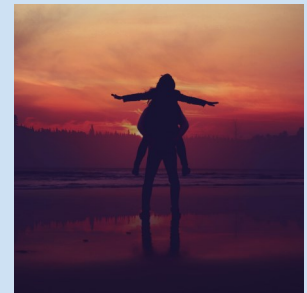


Truth 2: God Has Made Prayer Possible For You through Jesus Christ

1 John 5:14-15 is clear that when we pray according to God’s will he hears our prayers and responds. Prayer is not wishful thinking, but a clear line of communication between God and his children. More than hearing us these verses also ensure us that God does respond when his children pray.
