

# **REQUERIMENTS TO GET MARRIED IN SPAIN**

## **(FOREIGN & SPANISH CITIZENS)**

### **1- BOTH FOREIGNER & SPANISH:**

- ✓ Application form provided by the Civil Register.
- ✓ Copy of the passport or Residence/Work permit/DNI.
- ✓ If there are children from the relationship, Family Book or birth certificates.

AND

### **2A- SPANISH:**

- ✓ Original literal birth certificate no older than 6 months from.
- ✓ Original certificate of registration at the town hall ("empadronamiento") of his/her residence address(es) of the last 2 years. No older than 3 months.
- ✓ WIDOW: certificate of marriage and certificate of death of the late partner.
- ✓ DIVORCED: certificate of the previous marriage and firm divorce decree.

### **2B- FOREIGNER:**

- ✓ Original birth certificate issued not more than 6 months ago duly legalised by UG MOFA and the Consulate and translated to Spanish language.
- ✓ Original certificate of registration at the town hall ("empadronamiento") of your residence address(es) of the last 2 years. If in Uganda, certificate of residence in Uganda from the Consulate. No older than 3 months.
- ✓ Original certificate of civil status issue by URSB and the consular certificates of civil status and non-edict need ("certificado de no edicto"). Ugandans abroad are exempt of 21 days of marriage warning.
- ✓ WIDOW: certificate of marriage and certificate of death of the late partner duly legalised and translated to Spanish.
- ✓ DIVORCED: certificate of the previous marriage and firm divorce decree duly legalised and translated to Spanish.
