

OFFICIAL SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT RULES

SCOREKEEPING

- > Teams must turn in their official roster and signed liability release to the Director prior to playing their 1st game. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- ➤ Home team will keep the official book and be book of record.
- ➤ Each team is responsible for submitting scores to site director.
- ➤ Birth Certificates must be available on game site at all times during the tournament.

STARTING/ENDING THE GAME

- >Coin flip (by umpires) will determine home team. Higher seed team is home during playoffs.
- Teams may warm-up in the outfield grass before their game if time permits. Game time is "Forfeit Time" be ready to play. No formal infield/outfield is allowed prior to the game. No soft-toss into the chain link fence is allowed.
 - Time-Limits are established to keep games running on time and allowance for field preparation prior to each game and will be 1 hour 15 minute no new inning.

▶BATTING ORDER:

- Teams may bat 9
- Teams may bat 9 (with a DH)
- Teams may bat 10 (EH and DH)
- Teams may but entire lineup if they choose if they but entire lineup they must stay that way unless its because of injury.
- >TIES stand in **pool play** to ensure staying on time during tournament.
- During the Championship Game there will be NO Time-Limit. Mercy Rules will still apply.

(Inclement weather may require adjustments)

>PLAYOFF TIES:

- ➤ In the event of a tie at the end of time in playoffs or regulation play, the "Kansas City Tie Breaker Rule" will be used. IE: The last recorded put at 2nd Base and there will be (1) out, play will continue until a winner is determined.
- >Mercy Rules applied: 8-run lead after 5 innings, 10-runs after 4 innings, & 15-runs after 3 innings.
- All teams MUST pick-up their trash and debris following completion of their games.
- All teams are asked to retrieve foul baseballs while playing in a game.

EOUIPMENT

NFHS Softball rules will be used when others not specified in this document.

UMPIRES

Umpires will settle all field issues. Any protests will be presented to the Site Director with a \$100.00 fee, protest must be presented before the next pitch. The game will continue, if the protest is won (TBD later) the 100.00 fee refunded.

SPORTSMANSHIP

All players, coaches and fans will be expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanship manner at all times. If a coach is ejected he will not be allowed to attend the next scheduled game.

SEEDING DETERMINED IN ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) Pool Play Record
- 2) Head to Head matchup
- 3) Runs Allowed (Maximum 7 run per game)
- 4) Runs Scored (Maximum 7 runs per game)
- 5) Run Differential
- 6) In the event tie still exists a coin toss will decide it.
- ~ Rules not specifically covered shall follow National Federation High School Association.
