

Historian John Medkeff Jr. became interested in Riverview Cemetery in 1996, when he began researching the history of Delaware's brewing industry. He discovered that many individuals and families connected to Wilmington's 19th and 20th century breweries, saloons, and bottling plants were buried at Riverview. John will lecture and sign his book which will be available for purchase.
