Jesus is Lord - But is He YOURS?

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The Difference Between Savior and Lord

Many, when they receive Jesus, receive Him as Savior - the One Who died for their sins and rose on the third day, but do not make Him their Lord. **Romans 10:9** tells us, "That if thou shalt *confess with thy mouth* the *Lord Jesus*, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, *thou shalt be saved*." In other words, when you make Jesus your Lord, He will automatically become your Savior. Why? Because when you make Jesus your Lord, you will do what He says and get His results (i.e., salvation, which includes deliverance, protection, wholeness, prosperity, peace, joy, love, etc.).

Unfortunately, what happens many times is that people receive Him as Savior and nothing more. Therefore, salvation belongs to them and is available to them but because they do not make Jesus their Lord and do not do what He says, they do not experience that salvation. Instead, they live a life of hopelessness, failure, disappointment, defeat, and things God never meant for us to experience. Why? Because they get the salvation but have no idea how it works. Jesus is the One Who teaches us how it works.

Have You Made Jesus Your Lord? (The Litmus Test)

Have you made Jesus your Lord? I'm not asking you if you're saved. The answer does not lie in whether you believe in God or if you've prayed the "sinner's prayer" or how long you've been going to church or even how long you've been in ministry. The answer lies in your response to this question:

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Is Jesus saying this to you? *And why call ye Me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things* which I say? (Luke 6:46).

If you are not living a life of obedience to God - Jesus is not your Lord. You probably find yourself struggling with sin, lack, depression, disappointment, failure, sickness... the list goes on. You're either wondering if this "faith thing" really works or you're resigned to thinking that what you're experiencing is all there is. If you are truthful with yourself, you may even find that you are angry with God.

It doesn't have to be that way. God is good. His Word is true. And His life is abundant. You can make Jesus the Lord of your life today.

What Does It Mean To Make Jesus Your Lord?

Making Jesus Lord simply means turning the reigns of your life over to Him - allowing Him to become your Master and to teach you how to live. **Romans 10:9** in the Message Translation says it like this: "Say the welcoming word to God-' Jesus is my Master'-embracing, body and soul, God's work of doing in us what He did in raising Jesus from the dead. That's it."

Jesus doesn't want to be your Lord so He can be your mean, bossy taskmaster. Rather, He wants to be your Lord so He can show you how to access everything God has for you. In **Matthew 11:29-30**, He says, "Walk with Me and work with Me—watch how I do it. *Learn the unforced rhythms of grace. I won't lay anything heavy or ill-fitting on you*. Keep company with Me and you'll learn to *live freely and lightly*" (MSG).

If you're not living freely and lightly; if you're not walking in unforced rhythms of grace; if you're experiencing heaviness and ill-fitting circumstances, you might want

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to ask yourself who your master is. If Jesus is your Lord (Master), He will teach you how to overcome those circumstances. He will relieve you of the heaviness. He will teach you how to walk in the anointing that He walked in when He was on the earth.

Make Jesus the Lord of Your Life Today

If you want to make Jesus the Lord of your life - whether it's for the first time, or after realizing that you have allowed someone or something to replace Him as Lord of your life, allow me to lead you in prayer. Say this prayer out loud:

Jesus, thank You for loving me. Come into my life. I make You my Lord.

I'm done with trying to do things my way. I give You the reigns of my life.

I turn from my way of doing things and turn to Your way of doing things.

Thank You for teaching me how to live the God-life.

I choose to listen to You. I choose to do what You say.

I thank You for teaching me how to walk like You, talk like You, think like You, love

like You, live like You -

BE like You.

My past no longer matters.

My future is bright in You!

I receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit.*

I receive the power to live the God-life that You have given me.

I receive my supernatural prayer language.*

I receive my victory.

I receive your love.

In Jesus' Name.

Amen.

Activate What You Have Received

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To God be the glory for the things He has done! I would be remiss if I did not offer you the chance to activate what you have received. If you have been blessed by the things you have learned in this ebook, I would like to encourage you to give, or to "sow on it."

Sowing in this context is a spiritual principle where one plants finances in the Kingdom of God as a faith expression that they have received the Word that has been taught. It is also a faith expression that says they expect to see that Word manifest in their life. Many would equate this kind of giving to giving an offering, but it is so much more.

When sowing a financial seed into a ministry or church, etc., you are not just giving an offering or making a charitable donation. Sowing a financial seed is what one does when one personally receives the Word that was delivered and earnestly expects to see that Word come to pass in his or her life. It is your faith expression that says you believe the Word you have heard. It is also the impetus that activates the operation of that Word in your life. It is NOT a form of buying a blessing. NEITHER is it a selfish motive of giving to get. Rather, it is a spiritual law - the law of sowing and reaping.

Look with me at **Galatians 6:7**: Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap (emphasis added). Just as we cannot change the natural law of gravity, we cannot change the spiritual law of sowing and reaping. The next verse (v 8) says: For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.

Activate What You Have Received

John 6:63 tells us that God's Word is Spirit and It is life. Therefore, the Word that

you are responding to is Spirit. When you sow your financial seed, you are sowing to

the Spirit, and of the Spirit, you shall reap life everlasting.

What is life everlasting?

Jesus explained in **John 17:3**, "And this is life eternal, that they might know Thee the

only true God, and Jesus Christ, Whom Thou hast sent." So, when we sow to the

Spirit, we reap life everlasting, which consists of an intimate knowledge of God - the

Father and Originator of revelation Who wants to reveal every aspect of Himself to us

(see James 1:17) - and His Son, Jesus, Who is the Word (John 1:1, 14) and the

express Image of His Person (Heb. 1:3). Hallelujah!!!

As you sow your seed, sow it in faith as demonstration that you believe you receive a

harvest of this Word in your life. Be blessed, in Jesus' Name.
