Sermon Outline:

God Encounters: They change people. Some of the ones I mentioned during this sermon series were: Ezekiel 1:1-28, the conversion of the Apostle Paul on the Road to Damascus and Isaiah's vision. Let's look at one of them:

Isaiah 6: <u>Isaiah's Commission</u>

lsa 6:1 In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord seated on a throne, high and exalted, and the train of his robe filled the temple. Isa 6:2 Above him were seraphs, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. Isa 6:3 And they were calling to one another:

"Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory."

lsa 6:4 At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke. Isa 6:5 "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty."

lsa 6:6 Then one of the seraphs flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. Isa 6:7 With it he touched my mouth and said, "See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for."

lsa 6:8 Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

lsa 6:9 He said, "Go and tell this people:
" 'Be ever hearing, but never understanding;
be ever seeing, but never perceiving.'
lsa 6:10 Make the heart of this people calloused;
make their ears dull
and close their eyes.
Otherwise they might see with their eyes,
hear with their ears,
understand with their hearts,
and turn and be healed."

There are quite a few observations that you can glean from this short closing passage. For our purposes today, we are just going to look at three:

Team, Send and Full Time
T.E.A.M.: T Everyone Achieves More
There are the go-ers on the team, there are the senders too & all should be praying!
Send:
These missionaries on Paul's team were supported by established Churches and mature Christians, that is what "s" meant back then.
And what were these missionaries doing full time? They were making disciples of unbelievers and believers. Unless this and revival happens, there is no glue to hold the church together. We will keep growing in attendance and then losing people.
Do you keep in touch with people who stood n you at a concert?
Discipleship is relationships It is disciplined, applied study in a relationship, empowered by the Holy Spirit


Full Time

These people could not have traveled around or taken direction from Paul to go here or there if they were not full time committed to this work. We often miss this because we can go on a short term mission trip and be back in a week. We can go to Belle Vernon, shop and be back in an hour if there are no lines. Do you know how long it took to go to Belle Vernon in the 1800's? It was probably an all day event.

Conclusion of these observations:

The reason we had this vision is because that is how you should start a church: Full time teams meeting lost people and discipling believers and unbelievers, developing leaders and celebrating harvest (when the time comes) until a church forms.

John Wesley, 'If I had 300 men who feared nothing but God and hated nothing but sin and were determined to know nothing among men but Jesus Christ and Him crucified then we could set the world on fire!'

The very heart of ministry is to go out to the people who Jesus left His Throne in Heaven
for and connect with them. That is ministry. Everything else is celebrating that we
