

Bible Story Time



Aaron's Rod Buds

Numbers 17:1-13

And YAHWEH spoke to Moses, saying,

Speak to the sons of Israel, and take from each of them a rod, for a father's house, from all their rulers, for the house of their fathers, twelve rods. You shall write the name of each on his rod. And you shall write Aaron's name on the staff of the tribe of Levi; for one rod shall be for the head of their fathers' house.

And you shall place them in the tent of meeting, before the testimony, where I shall meet with you. And it shall be that the man's rod which I choose shall blossom. And I shall cause the murmurings of the sons of Israel, which they are murmuring against you, to stop from Me.

And Moses spoke to the sons of Israel, and all their rulers gave to him one rod for each ruler, one rod for a ruler, for their fathers' house, twelve rods; and the rod of Aaron was among the rods. And Moses placed the rods before YAHWEH, in the tent of the testimony.

And it happened on the next day, Moses went into the tent of the testimony, and, behold! The rod of Aaron for the house of Levi had budded, and put forth buds, and bloomed blossoms, and bore ripe almonds.



And Moses brought out all the rods from before YAHWEH to all the sons of Israel. And they looked, and each one took his rod.

And YAHWEH said to Moses, Put back the rod of Aaron, before the testimony, to be kept as a token to the sons of rebellion. And you shall end their murmurings from Me; and they shall not die.


And Moses did as YAHWEH had commanded him; so he did.



Bible Lesson: YAHWEH Chooses

Just before Yahweh's request for the tribal rulers to present their rods before Him, Korah, Dathan, Abiram, and everyone with them had rebelled against Moses and Aaron. Some were not happy with the situation they were in, having to wander in the wilderness for 40 years. Others, like Korah, were not satisfied with their position in the Congregation and wanted more.

So to stop the rebellion, Yahweh decided to have the rulers bring their rods to Him so that the one that would blossom would show whom He had chosen. Rods during this time were symbols of authority and it was Aaron's rod that Yahweh used to bring down the judgements upon Egypt. It was truly a miracle when Aaron's rod had blossomed the next day. And it not only had blossomed, but also budded and bore ripe almonds! All stages of the almond lifecycle were on display showing that this could only be by the hand of Yahweh. There was no doubt that Yahweh had chosen Aaron for the priesthood.

Today, Yahweh has placed over His Congregation leaders to help guide, protect, and care for His people. Whenever we are not happy with a situation we should always go to Yahweh, who is ultimately in charge, instead of rebelling and causing division and strife in the Congregation.

Snack Recipe:

A healthy snack you can prepare
And share with your family!

"Aaron's Rod" Snack Sticks

Ingredients:

- 6 pretzel rods
- ½ cup of dark chocolate (3 oz. or 90 grams)
- 1 teaspoon of coconut oil
- ¼ cup slivered almonds



Directions:

1. Line a *cookie sheet* with parchment paper.
2. Ask an adult to help you fill a medium-sized saucepan with a couple inches of water and bring to a boil. Then reduce heat to a simmer on low heat.
3. Next, have an adult help you to place a heat-safe bowl or a small pot over the saucepan with the simmering water, making sure that it does not touch the water.
4. Break up the chocolate bar into pieces and add it to the bowl along with the coconut oil. Stir until melted.
5. Remove the bowl from the heat and turn off the stove.
6. Dip the pretzel rods into the bowl of melted chocolate so that half of the pretzel is covered in chocolate.
7. Place the chocolate dipped pretzels onto the parchment paper and sprinkle slivered almonds on top of the chocolate.
8. Let set at room temperature, or you can place in the refrigerator for 10 minutes.
