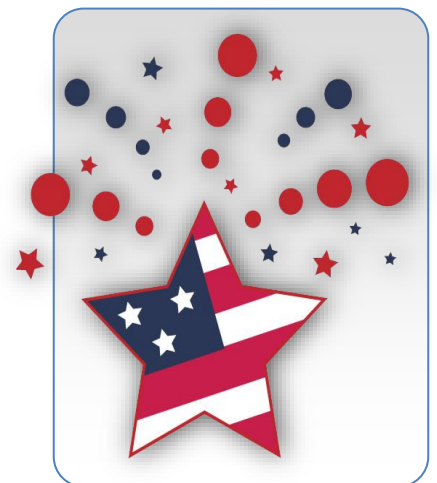
Stony the road we trod,
