CONGREGATIONAL MEETING NOTICE: On Sunday, May 9th, we will have a brief congregational meeting during the announcement time at both worship services to approve concrete and roofing repairs to our property. The roofing work will install a cricket system to repair a leak at the chimney of the church and replace missing shingles on both buildings. The cost for the roofing repairs is quoted at \$2,309. The concrete work is primarily at King's Kupboard. The quote of \$6,281.25 is to replace broken concrete in the handicapped parking area at King's Kupboard and repair concrete on the steps to King's Kupboard. Concrete work will also be done to repair the steps at the front of the church, for a total of \$650. Copies of these quotes are available on the bulletin board in the narthex.

RESUMING IN-PERSON WORSHIP: We have resumed weekly Sunday services in person at 8:30am and 11:00am in the sanctuary. Masks and social distancing are required, as well as additional measures and modifications to our worship services, similar to our worship last fall. Even if you have already received a COVID vaccine, these measures are still necessary, as the CDC is uncertain as to whether the vaccine prevents transmission of the virus. Worship will still be recorded and posted online weekly, by approximately 1 pm on Sunday.
