

The Lyerly Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, November 16, 2021 at Lyerly Town Hall. Those in attendance were:

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Ferguson at 7:05 pm.

New Business:

Juanita Baker said that she is going to be out of town the second Tuesday of next month so she would like for us to have the Christmas Party on the first Tuesday so she can be here. Mayor Ferguson said that would be December 7th. Juanita Baker said that her daughter is having her hand operated on so she will not be here. Mayor Ferguson asked everyone if that was okay with them. Phil Brooks and Shirley Davis said that it would be fine. Mayor Ferguson said that it will be on Tuesday, December 7th. Shirley Davis asked if it would be at the community center.
