Reverend Dr. Nadolyn Woody-Dunigan

The Reverend Dr. Nadolyn Woody-Dunigan is a native Memphian, raised in North Memphis and baptized at Hill Chapel Missionary Baptist Church where she also accepted her call the Ministry of the Gospel. She was licensed to preach in August 1995. At Hill Chapel, she co-organized the Women's Ministry, the Married Couples Ministry, and developed the Department of Christian Education. Dr. Dunigan was commissioned as a Teacher trainer for Evangelism Explosion Inc., (Coral Ridge, Florida) with the ability to establish Evangelism Clinics globally. In September 2007, she was ordained as a Minister of the Gospel by her current Pastor, Rev. Dr. Gina M. Stewart at Christ Missionary Baptist Church. Dr. Dunigan was commissioned a Stephen Minister in 2007.

A product of the Memphis City Schools, she graduated in 1972 from Northside High School. She earned a Bachelor of Science in Criminology/Criminal Justice from the University of Memphis. In May 2011, she received a Master of Arts in Religion graduating Magna Cum Laude from Memphis Theological Seminary. Dr. Dunigan attended Norris City Illinois Bible Institute and received a Doctor of Ministry degree in Leadership from Memphis Theological Seminary on May 14, 2016.

She is receive an Esther Award from the National Coalition of Women in Ministry in 2018. She has traveled abroad to Guyana and Jamestown South America as a delegate in Pastoral Excellence with the Lott Carey International Mission where she was assigned to the Abram Creek Missions Church. She is a graduate of the Memphis Police Department Clergy Academy.

At Christ Missionary Baptist Church, she has served as Director of Christian Education and Pastor of Disciple Development. In May 2014, She was elevated to her current position as Pastor of Congregational Care where she overseers several ministries. The Deacons Ministry, the Shepherd's staff, and First response Team (ministering to the congregation in time of illness, bereavement), and the Koinonia Fellowship

In her secular career, Dr. Dunigan retired in 2010 after 32 years as Deputy Administrator of Shelby County Government Pretrial Services Court Operations and County Probation. Appointed under three County Mayor Administrations, she was second in command overseeing the department on a \$3.5 Million Annual budget, and authored a \$300,000 grant to develop Tennessee's first and only Day Reporting Center for criminal offenders. She is the wife of Deacon David Dunigan, celebrating 30 plus years of marriage. She is one of two daughters of Viola Woody Taylor and the late Pastor Willie Woody.

She states, "Jesus is the Lover of my Soul and I am living in the Shadow of the Cross."

The Wounded Women Project (WWP) was established in Memphis Tennessee. The mission of this ministry is to reach broken and wounded women through a unique dramatization of personal testimonies from women who were once wounded themselves. 


