Call meeting to order/roll call

James Swigart called the meeting to order at approximately 4:30 P.M. Swigart – Chair, Craig Barber – Vice Chair, Heather Enzi – Member, Kayla Musselman – Member, were in attendance.

Pledge of Allegiance

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

General Public Comment (FIRST)

Dick Gardner introduced himself as the new County Commissioner for our area effective January 1, 2021.

Approval of the August 25, 2020 agenda

Rebecca Hansen stated no changes.

Musselman motioned to approve. Enzi seconded; motion passed 4-0. August 25, 2020 agenda approved.

Approval of the July 28, 2020 meeting minutes

Musselman motioned to approve. Enzi seconded; motion passed 4-0. July 28, 2020 meeting minutes approved.

Approval of the August 11, 2020 cancelled meeting minutes

Musselman motioned to approve. Enzi seconded; motion passed 4-0. August 11, 2020 cancelled meeting minutes approved.

Correspondence, awards, department updates, and announcements

Hansen presented the correspondence:

- 2. Road to Recovery Moving to a New Normal, Nye County Action plan request to reopen in rural areas, dtd 8/12/20.
- 3. Tonopah Town Board and Tonopah Library District Board of Trustees meeting agenda for 8/26/20.
- 4. Road to Recovery Moving to a New Normal, Amended Nye County Action plan request to reopen in rural areas, dtd 8/19/20.
- 5. Gmail from Arnold Knightly, RE: COVID-19 task force action plan, dtd. 8/20/20.

Hansen reviewed the submittal of the Community Development Block Grant to apply for assistance with rehabilitation of Hadley roads. Let the Board know Engine 4 which is normally housed at RMGC is being repaired; a new module was ordered to install and continue troubleshooting the unit. County finished fog sealing on Pablo Canyon Road. Maintenance working on weeds at the ball fields and other Town areas. No use of the green waste dumpsters placed by Desert Green Disposal on 8/3 – 8/5. One new COVID-19 positive reported for Smoky Valley.

Swigart asked if the Commissioner's make the decision on who the grant money will go to. Hansen stated she believed the final say on which grants would move forward would be the BOCC and that CDBG was a state grant. Swigart recommended that Rebecca or Pearl start to attend every Commissioner meeting to state the importance and the decay of our roads; how they were maintained and not maintained anymore; how they are unsafe.

Barber asked if Pearl ever had a chance to attend the Commissioner's meeting to discuss the concerns about the resolutions regarding the maintenance of the roads and the one tax we receive versus the other 5 taxes they receive. Requested Pearl attend the next BOCC meeting as Nye County says the roads are no longer maintained by them and ask where is the resolution that shows they returned the maintenance to us. Requested the agenda item for the roads be placed back on our agenda. Hansen stated the last meeting Barber was in attendance it was requested Pearl reach out to Tim Dahl. He was out on vacation and got back with our office just before Pearl left for time off. We received the response that it is their interpretation the resolution to create the fund was acceptance of maintenance for the roads. Barber would still like to see where the County's resolution to give the maintenance of the roads back to the Town is. Barber recommended going to every BOCC meeting to ask that question. Hansen stated we can make public comment, but they do not have to acknowledge statements made in public comment. Swigart stated the residents of Hadley have the same right to good roads as any other Town in the County.

Review and approve invoices for the Town of Round Mountain

Enzi motioned to approve. Musselman seconded; motion passed 4-0. Invoices approved.
