Selected Update on the Work of the Church Officers

Joint Officer Meeting: September 14, 2022

The officers met to discuss plans for the auditorium and determined to suspend the plan for remodeling the auditorium adopted in the Spring of 2022 and instead hire an architecture and engineering firm to help us form a comprehensive plan to renovate and repair the physical plant to better serve the needs of the congregation. They will help us plan for and consider such items as:

- New roof in Education Building
- Test for mold, asbestos, and lead; redress as needed
- Insulate and provide HVAC for the upstairs of the "old building"
- Remedy any water leakage

- Remodeling and installation of HVAC for the church parlor
- Upgrade the AV system in the auditorium
- Install additional bathrooms upstairs
- Remodel auditorium, replace pews

Session Meetings: August - September, 2022

The Session generally meets the first Lord's Day of the month to discuss shepherding needs and concerns in the congregation and to pray for the affected households and individuals.

As part of its shepherding responsibility, the Session sent a letter to another PCA Presbytery asking it to investigate the Christian character of a teaching elder in light of the theology reflected in one of his recent writings, which has been alleged to reflect deviations from the constitutional standards of the PCA.

The Session has planned for an elder shepherding workshop on October 22.

The Session invited the Reverend Doctor Joseph Pipa to come preach on October 16 and missionary/church planter Reverend Andy Young to come preach in the evening of October 30.

The Session voted to restart the choir with RE Wil Davis as director. The timing and particulars will be determined later.

The Session approved the formation of a women's Bible study to consider the Epistle to the Philippians and utilizing a book by Melissa Kruger.
