### **Venue**

The Aitken Center is located on the University of New Brunswick, Fredericton campus, at 20 MacKay Drive, Fredericton, E3A 3S2. Directions are also listed later in this letter.

We are excited to have this new, amazing venue located right in the middle of Fredericton. In order to show the facility owners how awesome dog sport people really are and to ensure that we have access to this facility again in the future, we ask that everyone please follow a few simple rules.

- Dogs are not permitted anywhere in the Aitken Centre other than in the rink itself. No dogs in the lounge, washroom areas, etc...
- Washroom Facilities: Please do not take your dog with you to any of the public washrooms.
- These facilities will be open Friday until 7pm for those wishing to set up early, then again Saturday around 7am.
- Please pick up after your dogs

### **Judges**

### **Start times and Measuring (subject to minor changes once seeding & schedule confirmed)**

- Racing will start at 8:30am Saturday and Sunday.

Warm-ups for all Divisions will be 2 minutes for each team's first race of the day. Warm-ups will then go to 90 seconds for every race thereafter.

### Coming from the East

- From the Trans-Canada Highway #2:
- Take Exit 285B (HWY-7 toward Fredericton)
- At Set of Lights, Turn Right onto Regent Street
- Turn Right onto Montgomery Street
- At the end of Montgomery, go straight through a parking lot.

### Coming from the North (via the Princess Margaret Bridge - Rte 8)

- Take EXIT 69-A, which connects to COLLEGE HILL RD.
- Drive straight down College Hill Rd until you hit the end
- At the end of College Hill Rd, turn RIGHT into a big parking lot.
