 Greetings to all!***

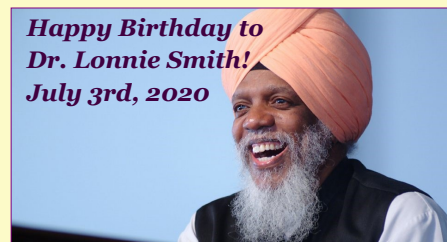

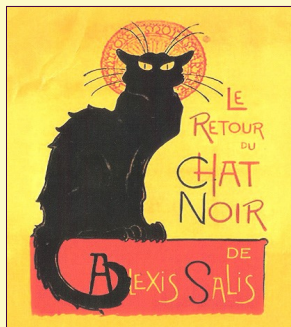

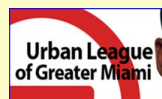
