INTRODUCTION

The Andover Soapbox Derby is a community event organised and supported by Andover Community Events. The event is being held to raise money for charities whilst creating a fun day for the teams, supporters and spectators. Fun & exciting designs are obviously highly encouraged.

CATEGORIES FOR TEAMS

There will be two categories of soapbox:

- Private (including charities and community groups)
- Business / Corporate

NB: Teams can have under 18 year olds but they are NOT to be Driver or Passenger.

HOW TO ENTER

- 1. Read the Rules and Regulations of this Race Pack
- 2. Complete the Entry Forms for all the members of your team
- 3. Submit your entry and BACS payment for either:

Early entry fee if received by 31/01/2022

- o Private £40
- Corporate / Business £60 (which allows company branding, see T&Cs)

Entries after 31/01/2022

- o Private £50
- Corporate / Business £75 (which allows company branding, see T&Cs)

INSURANCE

COMPULSORY MEETING

There will be a health and safety meeting held in April (date tbc) All team members are welcome but it is a MUST for at least one member of your team to attend. More details will be given out closer to the time.

SPONSORSHIP

Our hope is to raise funds via each team's own sponsorship as well as direct sponsorship from local businesses. We would be very grateful if the entering teams could do their best to collect sponsorship from their friends, family and colleagues as they build their Soapbox. Every penny really does count. There will be a prize for the most sponsorship raised.

TROPHY CATEGORIES

There will be various Trophy Categories on the day including

- Private Category 1st, 2nd & 3rd
- Business / Corporate Category 1st, 2nd & 3rd
- Team raising the most sponsorship for our charity partner

Scores will be a combination of Run time and Design.



Rules

SOAPBOX SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. Should not exceed 100kg in weight (not including driver).
- 2. Should not exceed 1.5m in width.
- 3. Chassis clearance should not be higher than 30cm from the ground.
- 4. Wheelbase from front axle to back axle should not exceed 2.5m.
- 5. Wheel's diameter should not exceed 67cm.
- 6. Should not have any mechanical parts to increase its speed (no catapults, pedals, jet or any other engines).
- 7. Must have a rigid steering system (no ropes).
- 8. Must have a rear wheel(s) braking system as a minimum.
- 9. Must have a minimum of three wheels.
- 10. Must not have any design elements to endanger themselves or the public (i.e. no sharp metal objects, mirrors or glass).
- 11. The soapbox must have a solid floor.
- 12. No part of the soapbox must extend beyond the width of the soapbox (no dangerous projections).
- 13. A soapbox derived from an existing chassis is permitted provided that it complies with the rules.
- 14. A soapbox not complying with the above specifications may be allowed to run if it complies with the safety regulations, but it will not be eligible for any of the prizes.

SOAPBOX RACE

- 1. The Soapbox runs will start at West Portway Industrial Estate, Hopkinson Way at 1:00pm.
- 2. Timing will be electronic
- 3. Teams must register at the entry table before unloading their vehicle, here they will be told where to set up.
- 4. There will be a Drivers' Briefing at 12:30pm, all drivers MUST attend or they will not be allowed to ride.
- 5. The race is open to all homemade soapboxes, all of which will race against the clock, one at a time. A start ramp will be in use. Once the soapbox has been removed from the circuit the next soapbox competitor will start.
- 6. All racers will be scored on overall spectacle in their category and also speed. (see information details for trophy categories.)
- 7. The soapbox and all remains must be removed immediately after the soapbox run.
- 8. By taking part in the Andover Community Events Soap Box Derby you will be required to comply with, and be bound by the rules and regulations of the event at all times and in particular:
 - Ensure that your soapbox is in good working order before attending the event
 - You accept that by taking part in the event you will understand that soapbox racing
 can contain certain inherent risks. You will participate entirely at your own risk and
 accept that the event organisers are not liable for any loss, damage, claim, expense,
 injury or accidents which may arise as a consequence of negligence. You will remain
 responsible for your own property and actions.
 - We ask that participants have appropriate sports insurance cover in place. If you do
 happen to hurt yourself personal sports cover will help cover medical costs and
 associated costs.



FIRST STEP APPLICATION FORM

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This is a short version of the main application form so you can claim your place in the soapbox derby. When you send this in and your payment has been made you will receive the full one for you to complete when you have your full team details.

The rules and regulations of the event have been drawn up for the benefit of the competitors and spectators and must be strictly adhered to. By signing them you are agreeing on behalf of your whole team to having read and agreed with all terms and conditions.

Teams must pay the entry fee to guarantee a position in the Andover Soapbox Derby.

- Payment is to be by BACS or cheque. (If BACS use team name as reference)
- Please note that the entry fee is non-refundable, and soapboxes will only be allowed to race subject to rules of the event.
