Dear brothers and sisters,

We have entered the Fall Season and with it the parish starts fully all the pastoral activity. I am happy to welcome all those who participate in our Religious Education Program, parents, and children/youth. Also, we had already the first meeting of the Core Team and planning has begun for the meetings of the Youth Group. Our Rosarians already met and are spearheading a 24-hour Eucharistic Adoration on October 12 and 13. The Portuguese community is starting to prepare for the Mass and Procession of Our Lady of Fatima on October 12. The Spanish Community is already doing events to fundraise for the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe on December 12. We are also going to start a Married couples course in Spanish in October and soon a Bible Study in English. The Cardinal has asked us to take this time to "re-open" the parish in a different way. We cannot continue doing the things the same way and expect a different result. For this reason, I have formed a task force in the Pastoral Council to help me organize a new approach to the parish (St. John Paul II called it New Evangelization). The Neocatechumenal Community of the parish is helping me to do house visitations through the whole borough so that everyone can listen the Good News. My dear parishioners, we cannot be a parish that only lives in the past, we need to bring Christ to the people and for that we need to have a serious meeting with Christ. For this, I invite you to take advantage seriously of all the opportunities that the parish will offer during this time to be with Christ and in Christ.
