Club Training times

This club trains in Plas Ffrancon Leisure Centre, Bethesda every: **Tuesday** 19:00-20:00 kids and adults mixed, **Thursday** 19:00 – 20:00 kids, 20:00-21:00 adults and kids 13yrs plus

Rules and Etiquette

- Arrive in good time. If you are late for a class, wait at the side of the dojo with your arm raised. When
 instructed, join the class quickly.
- Bow on arriving and leaving the Dojo (Training room).
- Out of respect, refer to your instructors by 'Sensei', not by their name.
- Be polite to other students, and respect those who are senior to you, both by grade and age.
- When your instructor is talking, give your full attention.
- Put a 100% effort into everything you do.
- Good behaviour, good manners and effort are key attributes in becoming a good karate-ka (karate student).

How much does it cost?

Lesson fee/Club Membership

We operate on club monthly membership scheme. After your free taster sessions the monthly rate is £35 for twice a week. This also allows you to train in clubs based in Llanddulas and Bethesda at no additional costs. This saves roughly £5 per month.

The monthly membership model has enabled us to maintain regular attendance and regulate class sizes. This is also the same kind of payment model in use by gyms etc.

Monthly fees payable during the first week of each month for that month. Adults over 18 can chose to pay as you train at £5 per session.

There are discounts available for families. For 2 members, monthly fee is £60, a saving £10 p/m, for three or more it is £65 per month, a saving of £40 p/m.

Standing Order is the preferred method of payment to keep admin times down to a minimum during class and promotes regular training.

Karate licence

All students **MUST** apply for a licence after 6 lessons. Students will receive a licence book; which includes insurances and registration with the Karate governing bodies. Licences run from April to March. Your instructor will explain the cost of a licence as it varies depending on when during the year you join. Every karate student from all clubs would require a licence, including instructors, it is your membership with the karate governing body's and provides the student's with member to member insurance.

Karate kit

All kit is available from your instructor. To start out you will need nothing more than a karate gi (suit) and a club badge to wear on the left side of the gi top. A basic karate gi costs approx £20 (depending on size). All kit can be purchased through on on-line shop, at www.shukokai-wales.com

Karate gradings

Every 3 months there is a grading for the next coloured belt. **Students who meet the criteria** for the grading will be invited to grade.

Gradings cost £20 for yellow belt to purple belt and £25 for a brownbelt grading. Students who pass will receive a certificate and be entered into the official records.

Sensei Andy is qualified to grade students up to their final brown belt (1st Kyu). Black belt gradings are done in Manchester by a panel of Senior Instructors including Sensei Denis Casey 8th Dan.
