RESUMING IN-PERSON WORSHIP: Beginning with Ash Wednesday services on Feb. 17th, and continuing with Sunday services weekly at 8:30 am and 11:00 am, we will resume in-person worship in the sanctuary. Even if you have already received a COVID vaccine, these measures are still necessary, as the CDC is uncertain as to whether the vaccine prevents transmission of the virus.
