Future books will be chosen randomly by picking the titles that have been suggested by members of the book club and kept in a container at the library.

We will start each meeting by choosing the next book so the library can check to see if they can get copies etc. while we enjoy a book club meeting.

Then I will ask the same 5 questions each time. Hopefully, that will then get everybody talking.

1. Who is your favorite character and why?
2. Did this book evoke any emotion in you?
3. Were there any surprises?
4. If you could ask the author, what would you ask?
5. How well did the author organize the plot and move along to appropriate ending.

Now you are prepared for the discussion. Hopefully, after answering these questions, more discussion will then be generated
