 - a. The November 20, 2018 Budget Hearing was called to order at 6:00 p.m. at the Niagara Town Hall

- 3. Discussion on budget
 - a. The Budget was presented by Treasurer Ellison, specifically pointing out the % increase or decrease.
 - b. MOTION (Neuens/Payette) to approve the budget. Motion carried. No negative vote.

 - a. MOTION (Payette/Neuens) to adjourn the Budget Hearing at 6:14 p.m.

Special Town Meeting

- 1. Call to order
 - a. The November 20, 2018 Special Town Meeting was called to order at 6:14 p.m.
- 2. Confirm everyone has signed the poll listing
 - a. It was again confirmed that all 10 electorates present signed the poll listing
- 3. Approve/Amend the agenda
 - a. MOTION (Haavisto/Geldmeyer) to approve the agenda as posted. Motion carried. No negative votes
- 4. Discussion/Action on approving the 2018 total town tax levy to be collected in 2019 pursuant to s.60.10(1)(a) of WI statutes.
 - a. MOTION (Geldmeyer/Vilringer) to approve the 2018 total town levy in the amount determined by the state of \$64,928. Motion carried. No negative votes
- 5. Establish the compensation for elected officers pursuant to s. 60.10(1)(b)1, Wis stat. (Any changes will become effective for officials elected with the start of the new terms.)
 - a. MOTION (Haavisto/Vilringer) to increase the elected officials wage 3%. The clerk wage increases to \$10,300 a year, the chair increases to \$4,753 a year, and supervisors to \$3,105 a year each; along with a \$25 stipend paid to any elected official who attends a meeting outside the monthly town meeting (this includes, but

is not limited to, WTA meetings, planning commission meetings, Lake District meetings, BOR meetings, educational meetings, and Municipal court meetings)

- 6. Adjourn Special Town Meeting
 - a. MOTION (Geldmeyer/McMahon) to adjourn the Special Town Meeting at 6:18 p.m. Motion carried. No negative votes

Regular Monthly Meeting

- 1. Call to Order and Roll Call
 - **a.** The November 20, 2018 Regular Monthly Board Meeting was called to order at 6:18 p.m. with, Chairman DeClark, Supervisor Neuens, Supervisor Payette, Treasurer Ellison and Clerk Johnson present.
- 2. Approve / Amend agenda items
 - a. MOTION (Neuens/Payette) to approve the agenda items for the November 20, 2018 board meeting. Motion carried. No negative votes
- 3. Approve / Amend minutes of October 16, 2018 Regular Town meeting
 - a. MOTION (Payette/Neuens) to approve the October 16, 2018 regular Town Board meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried. No negative votes.
- 4. Treasurer's report
 - a. MOTION (Payette/Neuens) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented by Treasurer Ellison. Motion carried. No negative votes.

- 7. Discussion/Action on the new contract with Anderson Tackman for the accounting service
 - a. MOTION (Payette/Neuens) to approve the new contract with Anderson Tackman for the accounting service to include a \$20 a month increase for a total of \$5,240 per year. Motion carried. No negative votes
- 8. Discussion/Action three-year road construction plan (2019-2021)
 - a. MOTION (Neuens/Payette) to approve the three-year road construction plan (2019-2021) which includes chip sealing Chapman road (possibly 2 miles), West road, and Provencher road one per year. Motion carried. No negative votes.
- 9. Discussion/Action on approving the proposed budget for 2019
 - a. MOTION (Neuens/Payette) to approve the proposed budget for 2019 including the levy and wages. Motion carried. No negative votes
- 10.Discussion Only on going into contract with land owners who request to have heavy loads delivered during weight limit season.

a. The WTA informed the town that we could charge a fee with a permit allowing a load to travel over roads during weight restrictions. We still need more information on specifics for the fee to charge.
