Contest open to Elementary through High School Students located In the Connellsville Area School District.








This is just an example, but gives you an idea of what we are looking for. Draw and color your flag, then illustrate in another area what the flag means to you.

Connellsville Flag

Contest open to Elementary through High School Students in the Connellsville School District.



Rules -

-Keep it Simple - The flag should be simple enough that a child can draw it from memory.

-Use Meaningful Symbols to the City of Connellsville - The flag's images, colors, or patterns should relate to what it symbolizes.

-Use 2-3 Basic Colors - Limit the number of colors on the flag to three, which contrast well and come from the standard color set (red, blue, green, black, yellow, and white)

-No Lettering or Seals - Never use writing of any kind or an organization's seal.

-Be distinctive and Be related to the City of Connellsville - Avoid duplicating other flags, but use similarities to show connections.

-Contest open to Elementary through High School Students located In the Connellsville Area School District.

-Submissions must be tuned in to the Appalachian Creativity Center located at 139 West Crawford Avenue NLT March 15.

-Connellsville City Council will pick two designs, during the March 16th City Council Meeting. One as a winner and one as a second runner up.

-All posters submitted will be on display in the windows of participating downtown businesses after the selection of winner and second runner up.

-Winner will receive a \$50 gift card and the second runner up will receive a \$25 gift card from a downtown business.

This contest is just for fun and is in no way a solicitation for a flag design for the City of Connellsville.
