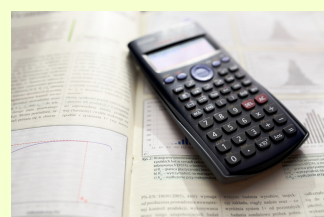


The LEAGUE
