Change in the <u>Drop-off & Pick-up Procedures Starting</u>
\*\*\* August 2, 2021\*\*\*

Parents starting Monday, August 2nd you will no longer enter through the Great Hall entrance. Parents will be able to bring their children downstairs to the ELC and sign them in and out at the front desk only. You will still be required to wear your mask during drop-off and pick-up.

The Drop-off time will be 7:00 AM to 9:30. Doors are promptly locked at 9:30. If you want your child to eat breakfast they must arrive by 9:10 AM. If you need to pick your child(ren) up anytime earlier or later than your scheduled time please call 216-321-1685. Children are not permitted to attend the ELC after 9:30 unless they have an doctors appointment and we are told at least one day prior to the appointment. To make a permanent time change, please email cwilliams@cotselc.org and you will receive confirmation of the change generally within 48 business hours. We want to accommodate our families wishes and hope that this adjustment is viewed as one step towards limiting some of our COVID-19 restrictions.

### Tuition Increase Reminder

Tuition is set each year by the Board of Trustees to meet the needs of a quality program. Tuition rates are generally set at the beginning of August but may be changed at other times. There is typically a 2-5% annual tuition increase. September 2021 statements will reflect the current rate set at that time. Tuition has not been increased in 2 years. Tuition is due weekly, IN ADVANCE of service, on Monday at the center's office. Payments should be made in weekly increments and may be paid 2 or more weeks in advance if this is more convenient. A 10% discount will be applied to the lower rate full tuition of a second child enrolled in the ELC from the same family.


## ELC Tuition Payment Options Available

Just a reminder that the following tuition payment options are available for your convenience:

- 1) Using a credit or debit card at the Center or on auto-pay with the Center (2% processing fee)
  - 2) Pay on line through a parent portal with a card (2% processing fee)
- 3) Setting up an auto draft agreement from a checking or savings account (\$1.00 fee per transaction)

Sign-up for auto-pay is available daily (ask at the front desk) and payment processing can begin on the date of your choice. Thank you to everyone who has already chosen this option! It makes billing and payment collection simple for both you and us!
