## WORDS

The Tenakh (Old Testament) is considered the dictionary of the entire bible. Everything you find in the Renewed Testament always originates in the torah or the Tenakh. Everything in the Renewed Testament always lines up with the Tenakh. If there is ever the slightest confusion or question, the Tenakh supersedes anything written in the Renewed Testament.

We know most things written in the Tenakh are accurately translated, whereas the Renewed Testament we know has thousands of translation errors. Keep in mind the bible as we know it was

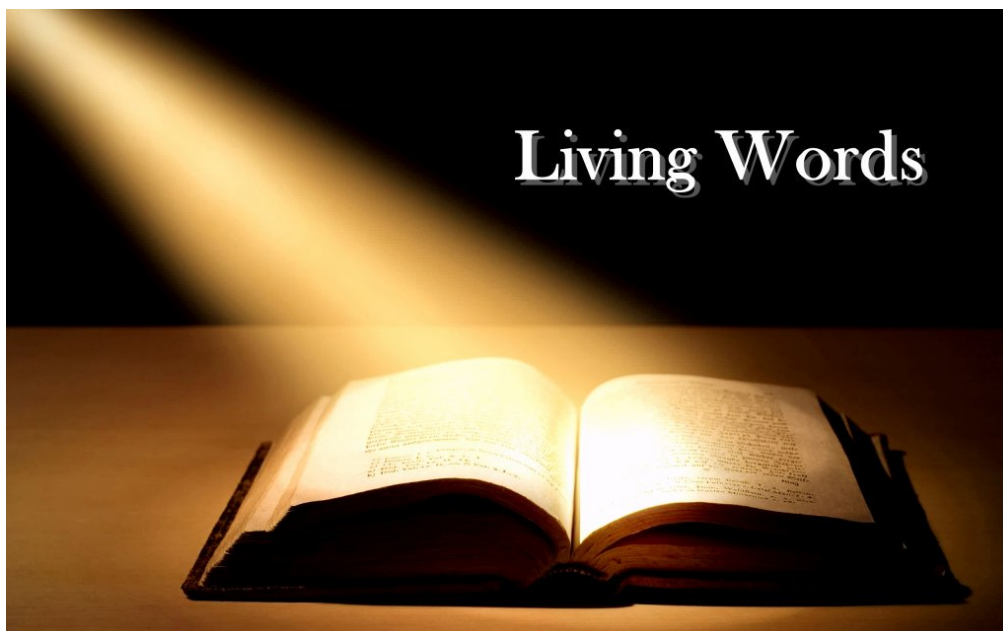
translated from its original Hebrew, to Greek, to Latin, to German, and then to English. During these processes there were thousands of mistakes made over many years. The gist of the scriptures still remains intact, but we know there are many errors. These translation errors are always what causes confusion with those trying to better understand the Living Word. For that reason, in the following teaching, we will have a close look at what commonly misunderstood words used in christianity, really mean. If we can learn the true meaning of what some of the more common terms (words) are, it will give us a whole different outlook at our Holy Scriptures. Learning this truth will open the doors of revelation and help set us free from the bondage of religion. It's time people checked things out for themselves and got away from trusting pastors and preachers who do not know the Word of Yahveh like most assume. We must check things out for ourselves. We must not be lazy and accept what others say as the truth, because over the last hundreds of years these lies and bad translations have caused too much confusion with Yah's people. Let's get back to the basics and see what the Words say in their original Hebrew meaning. When we see a writer mention the name of a place, an object or what have you, let's think like him when he was writing the scroll. Without knowing the traditions, customs, oral laws, etc. of these Hebrew writers, it's very difficult to understand exactly what the message is they are trying to put across. So let's try to understand some words that will help us grasp the depth of the Living Word spoken in scripture. That is why it is called the Living Word. This is the object of this teaching.

The meaning of words vary in different parts of the world. A flat in the UK is an apartment, a flat in Canada is a tire that has no air, or an area that is level for a distance, opposed to mountains or foothills. This is an example of a word used at the same time in different places with totally different meanings. When we read scriptures we must know what meaning the author had in mind when he wrote it. We must see it the way he intended us to see it.

Re-defining words in scripture is the main cause for the 38000 different denominations in christianity. If they would just stick to the original Hebrew, there would be few if any differences in the basics of our faith in the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. As long as our base is understood and agreed upon, the other things can always be worked out with love and understanding with each other. Now let's look at the words that will help us better understand the cyclical idea in scripture. The scriptures are cyclical. Yah's Living Word goes around and around, but it always leads us back to the tree of life, the torah. It all comes around in a circle back to the origin of the meaning of a few key words that are misinterpreted in most cases.

## **TENAKH**

The Tenakh is the complete Old Testament. This includes the torah, the scrolls of the prophets, and the other writings (Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Joshua, etc). The word Tenakh consists of the



three Hebrew letters: TNK. The “T” stands for the scrolls of Genesis through Deuteronomy. The “N” stands for the Prophets (Nevi'im). The “K” stands for the writings (Ketuvim).

## WORD

### What does the word “word” mean in scripture?

It means: speech, word, thinking, thing, mouth, utterance from the mouth. When we look at a few examples we quickly see it is describing, instructions, commandments, sword of the word, torah (law). It comes from two Hebrew words: “Dabar” and “Peh”. Dabar, H#1697 speech, word, thinking, thing.

The theme of torah is agricultural in its most simple form. In the bible the word “seed” and “word” mean the same thing (Luke 8:11 & John 1:1, 14). The Word is Yeshua. Yeshua is the one good seed. **Gal. 3:16** *Now the promises were made to Abraham and to his seed. It doesn't say, “and to seeds,” as if to many; on the contrary, it speaks of one — “and to your seed” — and **this “one” is the Messiah.***” One good seed, torah, the word, Yeshua. Abrahams seed in us. The word word (logos/ rema) is an abstract thing, a word, thought, thing, but in the ancient form it says it points to “a source of food gathering”. The word torah is an agricultural thing.

Let's look at an example in **Exod. 24:3-4** *Then Moses came and recounted to the people all the words of the LORD and all the ordinances; and all the people answered with one voice and said, “All the words which the LORD has spoken we will do!” 4 Moses wrote down all the words of the LORD. Then he arose early in the morning, and built an altar at the foot of the mountain with twelve pillars for the twelve tribes of Israel.*” Here we see it clearly means commandments, instructions. Let's look at another verse. **Num. 15:31** *‘Because he has despised the word of the LORD and has broken His commandment, that person shall be completely cut off; his guilt will be on him.’*” Here we again see it means commandments, instructions.

**Ps. 33:6** *By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, And by the breath of His mouth call their host.*” The utterance of Yah's word created the Heavens and the earth.

**Ps. 119:16** *I shall delight in Your statutes; I shall not forget Your word.*” Statutes are part of His instruction manual.

**Ps. 119:113** *Your word is a lamp to my feet, And a light to my path.*” This verse says it best, Yah's INSTRUCTIONS are a lamp unto our feet. Without His law (instructions) we are fumbling around in the dark.

Now let's look at a few examples of when “Peh” is used. **Peh** H#6310 mouth or utterance from the mouth, **Deut. 17:6** *“On the evidence of two witnesses or three witnesses, he who is to die shall be put to death; he shall not be put to death on the evidence of one witness.”* Here we see what comes from the mouth of two or three witnesses is called the word. This is used in a legal manner.

**Num. 20:24** *Now when they set out from Kadesh, the sons of Israel, the whole congregation, came to Mount Hor. 23 Then the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron at Mount Hor by the border of the land of Edom, saying, 24 “Aaron will be gathered to his people; for he shall not enter the land which I have given to the sons of Israel, because **you rebelled against My command** at the waters of Meribah.”* Here we see it means word, instructions. If you follow my word, instructions, roadmap, it will direct you. Remember that they are out in the wilderness.

**Num. 4:49** *The sons of Israel did so and sent them outside the camp; just as the LORD had spoken to Moses, thus the sons of Israel did.*” They did as they were told. they obeyed his commands.

**Exod. 17:1** *Then all the congregation of the sons of Israel journeyed by stages from the wilderness of Sin, according to the command of the LORD, and camped at Rephidim, and there was no water for the people to drink”.*

**Isa. 1:10** *Hear the word of the LORD, You rulers of Sodom; Give ear to the instruction (torah 8451) of our God, You people of Gomorrah.”*

**Micah 4:2** *Many nations will come and say, Come and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, And to the house of the God of Jacob, That He may teach us about His ways, And that we may walk in His paths.”* For from Zion will go forth the law (8451 torah), Even the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.”

**Gen. 34:26** *They killed Hamor and his son Shechem with the edge of **the sword**, and took Dinah from Shechem's house, and went forth."*

**Matt. 10:34** *"Do not think that I came to bring peace on the earth; I did not come to bring peace, but a **sword** (6310 sword)."*

When we speak the word, it can cut deep into someone's soul, like a sword for either good or bad. This is the basic principle of curses and blessings. The words coming out of our mouth can bless people or put a curse on them. Our words can create something positive, (the understanding of something, the truth, which can set us free), or it can confuse us, depending on our relationship with the Almighty. Wisdom comes from hearing and doing the word of Yahveh. Wisdom comes from respecting His Word and using it appropriately. The word can be used as a sword to cut out diseases when spoken as in the case of a blessing, or cause diseases to begin as in the case of a curse. Words can also be used for healing and deliverance.

**When we speak, the frequencies of sound that are used, can change substance in a spiritual manner.** Our words are frequencies (vessels so to speak) that can change things around us, including entities and substances. Words can bring forward life or death. **Eph. 6:17** *And take **THE HELMET OF SALVATION**, and **the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.**"* The word is His spirit.

**Rev. 2:16** *"Therefore repent; or else I am coming to you quickly, and I will make war against them with **the sword of My mouth.**"* His word can be used for fighting spiritual battles.

**Hebr. 4:12** *For **the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword**, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart".* His word divides. If you keep the word of Yah you become as a sword.

**Luke 4:4** *And Yeshua answered him, "It is written, '**MAN SHALL NOT LIVE ON BREAD ALONE.**'"*

Words can bring spiritual life in the same manner that food brings life to our physical body.

**Luke 5:1** *Now it happened that while the crowd was pressing around Him and **listening to the word of God**, He was standing by the lake of Gennesaret;"* Here we see Yeshua the Rabbi teaching the torah, the word.

**Acts 6:2** *So the twelve summoned the congregation of the disciples and said, "**It is not desirable for us to neglect the word of God in order to serve tables.**"* Here we see how the Renewed Testament words are connecting the word with the tenakh. When someone says they got a word from Yah it cannot contradict His written word. **1Tim. 4:4** *For **everything created by God is good**, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with gratitude;"* Everything spoken from the mouth of Yah at creation is good. That word, torah is special and sanctified.

**Hebr. 11:3** *By faith we understand that **the worlds were prepared by the word of God**, so that what is seen was not made out of things which are visible."* The very utterance of Yah created the world.

**John 1:1** *In the beginning was **the Word**, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God.**"*

Here we see the word is not just something that comes out of the mouth, but has become flesh, in the form of Messiah Yeshua. The people didn't seem to follow the torah that comes from the mouths of great men and prophets, so Yah sent His son to give it to them direct in a living form. The word of Yah is any utterance that has come from His mouth. When that word is directed to mankind, it is always tied to His law, His commandments, the written torah. **"I am the way, the truth and the light"**.

Every time you hear someone refer to the Word of God, as I have just revealed, you must understand they are referring to the torah (instructions) of the Most High dictated to Moses at Mt. Sinai. Yahveh uttered from His mouth the living word which is our instruction for life.

## **THE WORD IS THE ARMOR OF YAH**

Let's have a look at something commonly used as the explanation of the "Armor of God" often referred to in the christian churches. The armor is listed in chapter 6 of Ephesian's verses 11-19. Many believe Paul just came up with this armor of God idea and wrote it in the scroll, but this is not the case. Paul is simply expanding on what was said by Isaiah in Isa. 59:1-21. **Isa. 59:17** *And He put*

**on righteousness like a breastplate, And a helmet of salvation on His head; And He put on garments of vengeance for clothing, And wrapped Himself with zeal as a mantle.**

The seven pieces of armor are listed as: the girdle of truth, breastplate of righteousness, preparation of the true gospel on our feet, the shield of faith, the helmet of salvation, the sword of the spirit, and prayer and petition. Many acknowledge that the sword of the spirit is an incredible weapon, but few seem to realize exactly what the sword is. Look real close and see the sword is the WORD OF GOD! The Word of God explained previously is the torah/law/instructions/tenakh. The Word is living, and active, and sharper than any two-edged sword. **Hebr. 4:12** *“For the word of Yahveh is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.”* The Word is written in Yah's Hebrew alphabet. The aleph/tav ("et" in Hebrew, meaning from the beginning to the end), of the Hebrew alphabet are the letters Adonai used to speak all things into existence with.



**Eph. 6:17** *And take **THE HELMET OF SALVATION**, and the sword of the Spirit, which is **the word of God**." The "word of God" spoken of here is of course the instructions/torah/tenakh. The only offensive weapon we have is what proceeds from our mouth, and what emanates from our actions. Our sword is the Word (instructions) of Yah.*

This explains why so many who claim to be His people (usually christians) have absolutely no power and no authority in the Kingdom. They are dead in the water so to speak, and the enemy manipulates them as he pleases. Without being grounded in torah, Yeshua the cornerstone, the Word come alive in the flesh, you are simply standing on sand. This reveals why most christians over-all, cannot hear or see the truth of the written word. They carry curses over their lives which open the door to demons. Those demons (especially deception and anti-semitism), keep them from hearing the word (torah) when spoken. Until they OBEY His word and show them that they love Him (John 14:15), they will be blinded and unable to be born again.

### **LEAST IN THE KINGDOM**

The Hebrew letter "zayin" means sword. When we read the eight verses in Ps. 119:49-56 that start with zayin, because zayin means a weapon, these verses tell us that there are powerful weapons that Yah has given us. His name and His Word are our weapons. As a result of using these weapons His statutes will become our songs. *"Remember, this is, the arrogant, I have remembered,*

*burning indignation, thy statutes are my songs, I remember thy name in the night, this has become mine".*

Zayin brings life through death, a kind of a paradox. It brings life through death and nourishment through the "sword". You learn obedience through suffering. Even Yeshua said that He would suffer. You must die in order to be born again.

**Matt. 10:34** *"Do not think that I came to bring peace on the earth; I did not come to bring peace, but a sword".*

The sword (zayin) of the spirit is for the transfer of government. When we are truly born again, our salvation may be transferred to His government, but that doesn't mean you can't be in bondage. You may have the blessing of salvation, but not the blessings available to those who obey His Word on earth or in Heaven. One may get to heaven but they will be sorely disappointed when they find out on judgement day that all they get is to live in Heaven. There is such a thing as "least in the Kingdom of Heaven". Many people will say as long as they get to Heaven, that's all they care about. That is the wrong attitude. We should be wanting to make our Creator happy with our deeds on earth so that He is pleased with us in Heaven. We should be aiming for the bulls-eye, pursuing the perfect torah, so



that some day we may hear Him say; "well done my good and faithful servant". We want to enter Heaven not as the "least", but as the best.

**Matt. 5:17-19** (written in RED) *"Do not think that I came to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish, but to fulfill. For truly I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter or stroke shall pass away from the Law, until all is accomplished. "Whoever then annuls one of the least of these commandments, and so teaches others, shall be called **least in the kingdom of heaven**; but whoever keeps and teaches {them,} he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven."*

The job of the sword of the spirit is to go deep inside of you and hurt you. Its purpose is to destroy the part of you that is not of Him. There are two kingdoms in this world, one owned by Satan, and one owned by Yah. Satan is the one in authority over this world. We are in it, but we are not of it. When we are born again we are to no longer be under the spiritual authority of the things and ways of this world. Originally all authority on earth was given to Adam. Adam blew it, the moment he disobeyed. Adam handed over the keys of the Kingdom to the devil. Satan knew he had no authority over Adam and Eve, he knew the only way to take authority over them was if Adam would give him the authority by sinning (Rom. 6:23). The moment they sinned he took authority over the world. The government of Yah got transferred to the government of Satan. From that moment on Satan became the ruler over planet earth. Immediately after Adam and Eve sinned Yah had to leave the garden. That is why He has no right to help you unless you are in covenant with Him. He has no legal right to heal you, He has no legal right to hear your prayers, He has no legal right to help you until you are born again and in a covenant relationship with Him. He must abide by His own law. Everything must go according to the very law He based His Kingdom on. He cannot go against His law. This is the heavenly courtroom we are talking about here. It is the courtroom by which all things are judged. The consequences of Adam's mistake took away the legal rights of the very One who created him. Only when Yeshua returns as King will He have the legal right to do whatever He pleases on earth again.

### **What about the New Testament?**

There was no such thing as the New Testament at that time. The bible says if you take away or devalue from the word of God, you will be cursed. Your salvation may not be removed, but there will be restrictions on your life because of the curses in it. You cannot have the spiritual authority or legal right to things of His Kingdom when you are not keeping covenant with Him. The moment you disobey His instructions/law you give the enemy the legal right to put restrictions on your spiritual life. The only way to transfer back to His government is to repent and get back in line through faith and obedience. Don't expect the King to listen to or obey your prayers if you are out of covenant with Him.
