SUBJECT: DIVISION STATISTIC QUIZ FOR PUBLIC SECONDARY STUDENTS

- 1. In line with the celebration of the 27th National Statistics Month (NSM) and the 13th National Convention on the Statistics and as stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No.82, s. 2016, the SDO-Ifugao will conduct a Division Statistics Quiz at the Ammungan Hall, Roof Top, Division Office on September 29, 2016 at 8:30 AM onwards.
- 2. The objective of the statistics quiz is to instill awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of statistics among our students and teachers.
- 3. Each school shall conduct a Statistical Quiz to come up with their winners as participants to the Division Statistics Quiz.
- 4. Participants shall be the top one winner and coach for each school.
- 5. Confirmation of participants shall be emailed to EPS in Araling Panlipunan ekimayong@yahoo.com on or before September 26, 2016 following the format below:

- 6. Guidelines and Mechanics of the said Statistics Quiz is attached as Enclosure 1.
- 7. Transportation, per diem and a registration fee of one hundred (for AM snack and lunch) per participant shall be charged to school MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

GUIDELINES / MECHANICS OF THE DIVISION STATISTICS QUIZ

- 1. The contestant is the first top winner from Grade 7 to Grade 11 in each school. Each contestant shall bring his ID bearing his/her Learner Registration Number (LRN).
- 2. Substitution is not allowed during the Quiz proper.
- 3. No cell phones, tablets, or any other electronic communication devices are allowed during the competition.
- 4. There will be three (3) components in the competition: Easy Round, Average Round and Difficult Round.
- 5. Questions will include general information, basic educational statistics and general statistics.
- 6. Each question will have the following sequence:
- a. The quiz master will read the question projected on the screen twice. A timer will start after the quiz master says "GO".
- b. Each contestant will raise his/her answer card after the quiz master will say "TIME IS UP" until the scores are properly recorded.
- c. The quiz master will announce the correct answer for the questions. The assigned proctor will check each contestant's answer card to determine if his/her answer is correct or wrong. The proctor will raise a BLUE flag for a correct answer and a RED flag for a wrong or no answer at all.
- 7. In case of a tie, tie-breaker questions will be given until a winner is determined by the highest number of points. Each tie-breaker question will be given four (4) points.
- 8. Decision of the Quiz Committee shall be final and non-appealable.

EASY ROUND:

- 1. There will be ten (10) multiple choice questions with four (4) options worth two (2) points for each
- 2. Each question is timed for ten (10) seconds.
- 3. The scores of each contestant will be totalled and carried over to the next round.

AVERAGE ROUND:

- 1. There will be ten (10) multiple choice questions with four (4) options worth three (3) points for each question.
- 2. Each question is timed for twenty (20) seconds.
- 3. The scores of each contestant will be totalled and carried over to the next round.

DIFFICULT ROUND:

- 1. There will be ten (10) multiple choice questions with four (4) options worth five (5) points for each question.
- 2. Each question is timed for thirty (30) seconds.
- 3. At the end of the Difficult Round, all scores will be summed up and the top three contestants will be declared as the winners. The contestant with the highest number of points is automatically declared as the champion and the next winners as runner ups.
