## Color Splash parties

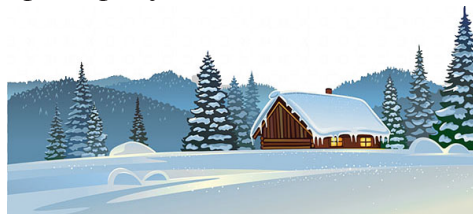
There will not be a Color Splash party in December because of the holidays.

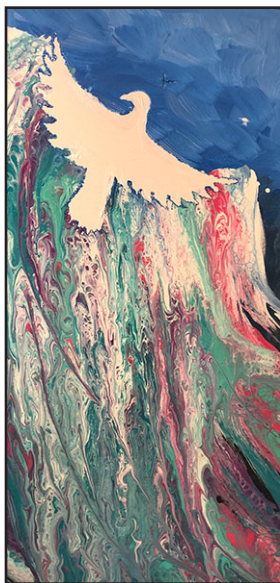
## Volunteering

## Current gallery exhibit extended



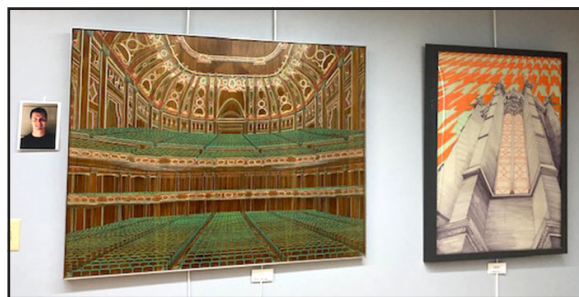
The Paul Brumaghim gallery currently features “Art Speaks” - a collection of works by home grown Vermilion County artists.

## Gallery exhibit for January & February

### *Paul Carson's Collection exhibit - Book, Posters and Art from Spanish Speaking Countries*

Our January and February exhibit in the Art League gallery will feature Paul Carson's collection of books, posters and art from the Spanish speaking countries he has visited.

Paul has lived in Danville since 1969 when he took a job at Danville High School teaching Spanish. Paul taught at the high school for 33 years and taught GED classes at DACC for 35 years.

Paul traveled each summer to improve his Spanish and to learn the cultures of each country.



He led 4 trips with students to Mexico, Central America and the Caribbean. Paul's favorite vacation destination is Ushuaia in Southern Argentina.

Paul's collection is truly amazing. It includes pottery, paintings, masks, nativities and wood carvings.

The exhibit will be open to the public from January 8 to February 28 during our open hours and private tours can be arranged by phoning the Art League for an appointment. Paul will give a lecture and guided tour at 2 p.m. on February 12.

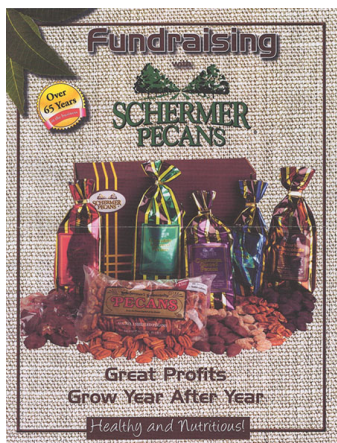
