This exhibition and competition is open to all artists and craftsmen, 18 or older and out of high school, in the Middle Georgia area, both member and non-member.

ELIGIBILITY

All middle Georgia artists, MGAA member or not, **18 or older and out of high school**, may enter up to three works in the applicable section. Work must be original and created by the artist since February 2020.

CATEGORY A: TWO-DIMENSIONAL

Section 1 Works on Paper, Canvas, Panel,
any medium
Section 2 Photography

CATEGORY B: THREE-DIMENSIONAL

Functional & Non-functional work, any medium,
and Fiber Art

LIST OF AWARDS

Because we had to cancel the Mulberry Street Festival in 2020 due to Covid 19, we have had to make some changes to the Winter Arts Festival. The awards this year will be based on the number of entries received per category and the entry fee is changed to \$10 per piece for members and \$20 for the first piece, \$10 for each additional piece for non-members.

SPECIFICATIONS

2D

All work must be framed (gallery wrapped canvases with painted edges are considered framed) and ready to hang with wire of adequate strength. No saw tooth hangers allowed.

3D

All work meant to be displayed on a wall must be ready to hang and not exceed 84"x60" (except for quilts). Free standing works must be no larger than 6' in height and must be self-supporting.

No heavy work or massive frames will be accepted due to the limitations of the hanging system. At the discretion of the MGAA Board, work containing lewd or explicit content will not be accepted.

If less than three entries per category are received, MGAA reserves the right to eliminate or combine categories.

SALES

Work must be priced for sale. Work marked NFS will not be accepted. Changes cannot be made after delivery of artwork. A 40% commission will be charged by MGAA on all sales. Member volunteers 15%.

All work must remain on display throughout the exhibition; no work will be released before March 12.

LIABILITY CLAUSE

The Middle Georgia Art Association will not be responsible for loss or damage to works of art submitted for this exhibition during handling, storage and display.

PENALTIES

Artists whose work is not delivered for exhibition will not be given a refund. Artists who break exhibition rules will be disqualified, their work will not be hung, and they will receive no refund.
