

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, January 11th, 2018 in the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan with one councillor absent.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on December 14th, 2017 were approved as circulated, the minutes of the December Special Meeting held on December 15th, 2017 were approved as presented, the Statements of Financial Activities for the month of December were accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council acknowledged receipt of the Fidelity Bond, authorized minimum positional WCB coverage for council for 2018, set 2018 wages, and authorized cemetery grants, various memberships, and the allocation of the R.M.'s population to the Village of Alida for funding under the 2018 Community Grant Program for Sport, Culture, and Recreation. Council directed a Request for Proposal for the supply of the municipalities diesel fuel requirements be advertised with a deadline for submission of February 6, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. and the opening to take place at the February 8, 2018 regular meeting of council at 1:30 p.m. One delegation was received.

Public Works Foreman, Girard, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

A number of road right-of way applications were approved by council for well sites, approaches and pipeline installations.

Correspondence was received and filed.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:30 p.m.
