Welcome to September - a month of new beginnings! It is a busy and exciting month for all of us. For teachers and children it's a month of change, new beginnings, new surroundings, new friends, new experiences, new skills, and new challenges.

This month your child will begin to explore the world of learning and developing many new and basic skills. We will begin the year by learning grace and courtesy by practicing the following:

- Hand-shaking with eye contact
- rolling out a work mat
- working co-operatively within our classroom
- choosing classroom work independently, working with it, and returning it to its proper place
- listening skills
- care of self, ie: putting on/ taking off shoes, coat, and washing, etc.

We encourage independence and the development of self-help skills in our students. We ask that you please say good-bye at the door and allow your child to change their shoes and put their jacket away on their own. A teacher will always be there to greet your child at the door and help your child if needed. Thank you!

We will be learning all about apples this month! We will learn about the apple life cycle, what we can use apples for and different types of apples. We will be doing some apple science and look at the different parts of an Apple. We will also be talking about Kindness, Peace and Self-Care. We will be beginning to introduce our Self-Care days and talking about how we can create a peaceful classroom and what it means to be kind and respectful.

We have a special birthday celebration at Montessori and we would like it if you could please send a picture of your child when they were born as well as a picture each year up until their current birthday and complete the questions that we send home. Show and Share

We will be officially starting show and share in October. Your child is welcome to bring in a show and share **once a month!** There will be a sign-up sheet on the front table at the beginning of each month. Please help your child choose something special to bring in for example a photo, one of their collections, a special memento from a trip etc. We ask that you do not send your child with a toy (action figure, doll, stuffed animal, lego.)

Show and Share is a really great way to allow children to develop their public speaking skills and self-confidence. It also allows them to think up questions and learn how to respectfully listen to one another.

Daily Tasks

Upon arrival at school, please read the communication board outside the classroom, it will outline what some of the activities will be that day. This may also help you to spark some conversation about what your child did in the classroom. If your child has anything to take home, it will be found in their file. This file will be placed outside the classroom every day and your child will have one with their name and picture on it. Any notices or invitations will also be found in your child's file. Please check these at the end of each day!

Please don't be alarmed if your child is not bringing home paperwork because in the Montessori classroom we are very progress oriented and a lot of the materials are to be used and left in the classroom. For example: a child may be working with many of the manipulatives such as "The Golden Beads", "Geometric Solids" or "Color Tablets" during their classroom sessions. These activities are in the classroom daily and cannot be taken home, therefore, they wouldn't bring home paperwork or finished products that would indicate they had worked with that particular activity that day.

Emails Needed!

We are paperless! Each month newsletters will be sent to your email account. Please take the time to read the newsletters. They often contain important information about what is happening in the classroom as well as specific dates and /or events coming up. If you do not receive a newsletter, please let us know. A monthly newsletter will be posted on the communication board inside the classroom. We will require all emails to make this happen and would appreciate it if you let us know if and when your email address changes.
