#### From the Nurture Team: Samaritan Purse ("Shoe Box") Project

We will once again be filling shoe boxes for needy children overseas. The shoe boxes are filled and wrapped in November so they can be shipped for the children to receive at Christmas. Last year we filled 36 shoe boxes and would like to match that again this year. In order to do this WE NEED YOUR HELP by donating items from the list below or by making a monetary donation and we will do the shopping. Monetary donations can also help to cover the shipping costs. Empty shoe boxes are also needed to fill!

The following are items needed to fill the shoe boxes:

Doll Bandages Small Manual Pencil Sharpener Underwear Stuffed Animal Sunglasses Colored Pencils Socks

Harmonica or Kazoo Small Cars, Trucks Pencil Case Flip-flops
Hairbrush Jump Ropes Crayons and Markers Hats



All the units will be helping at the Car Show in North College Hill on Labor Day. They will also have a recruitment booth for the upcoming year. Be sure to come see us!


# **Nursery School**
