LOUIS, MO – August 13, 2012 – Arts & Faith St. Louis, a working partnership between St. Louis arts, religious, and university leaders is excited to announce the second annual *September* 11th *Interfaith Memorial in Music: An appreciation of Religious Diversity*. The group aims to promote a "more harmonious St. Louis" by establishing an ongoing relationship between the arts and faith communities. The concert takes place on **Sunday, September 9, 2012 at 5:30 pm** in the perfect acoustics of the historic **Sheldon Concert Hall** (3648 Washington Blvd), and features renowned Grammy-winning soprano **Christine Brewer**, jazz pianist **Peter Martin**, American Soul artist **Brian Owens**, and the **Dickson String Quartet**, in addition to musical representatives from Buddhist, Christian, Jewish, Hindu, and Muslim faith groups. Plans for the evening also include the installation of a temporary interactive sculpture on Washington in front of the Sheldon, created by St. Louis artist **Lyndsey Scott.** The event is free and open to the public.

Following the show, audience members will have the opportunity to affix ribbons to the interactive sculpture as a physical sign of commitment to understanding, respecting, and working for peace in the face of religious diversity.
