# Taking the Fifth

According to the US Constitution taking the fifth refers to refusing to answer questions because in so doing one might incriminate oneself. I'm borrowing the title to hopefully answer some questions concerning our decision to have one service on 5th Sundays of the month.

The genesis of the idea was planted on several previous one service Sundays which were intended to highlight some unusual event. Rally Day - Children's Christmas program - Advent Fair, are examples. One of the delights of the holiday celebration is the opportunity to gather as a family. It usually cannot always be done but family members make special, sometimes sacrificial, efforts to do so at the holidays.

With 2 worship options in essence we become two congregations. On the surface there is nothing particularly negative about that fact. Yet we remain one congregation. It seems to leadership that occasionally the "two" congregations would benefit from meeting at the same time.

Schedules and time matter—of course they do. Yet in our personal lives we adjust occasionally especially when family is involved.

The worship style is probably a question. My proposal is that we alternate between our current 8:00 am & 10:30 am styles beginning with 8:00 am on January

There are usually 4 fifth Sundays in a calendar year. The constitution has not been changed and we will undoubtedly re-evaluate for 2017. We'll give it a try and see how it goes.

# POSITIONS AVAILABLE:

**Readers** - Read scripture reading during worship services. You choose either the 8am or 10:30am service. Done on a rotating schedule.

**Ushers** - Pass out bulletins, help people line up for communion, straighten sanctuary after service. You can choose either 8am or 10:30am worship service to volunteer. Done on a rotating schedule.

**Greeters** - Greet people arriving at church. Give directions or help answer questions they may have. Done on a rotating schedule.

Collators - Collate bulletins. Done on a rotating schedule on Fridays.

**Site Preparers** - Responsible for cleaning the Sanctuary. Rotating schedule. Takes approximately 1-2 hours to vacuum, dust and pick up trash depending on number of people helping. Done on a rotating schedule.

Gardeners - Adopt a flower bed to help keep the church property looking beautiful.

**Children's Sunday School** - Help needed to play parts/characters during the Bible lesson. All materials are furnished. Substitute teachers are also needed.

**Communion Preparation** - Prepares Communion on Sunday mornings. Done on a rotating schedule.

Nursery Attendant - Help in the nursery during the 10:30 worship service.



Our Food Pantry serves a large number of our neighbors in need. Without your help we would not be able to serve them.


