The Square on the Statues in the Square

It's a long time since I was in St Peter's Square in the Vatican - back in the last Millennium! - but there's a group of statues there now, "Angels Unawares" by the Canadian sculptor Timothy Schmalz.

There's a little square fixed to it, a QR code like on you Covid vaccination certificate, that links to information about the sculptor and about Catholic teaching on migration. The life-size bronze sculpture of migrants and refugees was in the square for over two years before the QR code was fixed to it, shortly after Pope Francis had encouraged people at his general audience to pray for migrants and refugees.

"Migration today is a reality to which we cannot close our eyes," the pope said. "It is a social scandal of humanity."

The title "Angels Unawares" cites Hebrews 13:2 which in one translation says "Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares."

The sculpture depicts a group of migrants and refugees from different cultural and racial backgrounds, and from diverse historic periods of time. Angel wings emerge from the centre suggesting the presence of the sacred among them.
