I stipulate and agree that, in addition to any other legal remedies that may be available, an action may be brought against me for replevin and/or specific performance. I understand and agree that, due to The Rescue's paramount interest of its adopted cats, attorney's fees and costs will be measured according to the amount of time spent regardless of the amount of money damages sought or awarded or the monetary value of the cat. I further agree that The Rescue will be entitled to possession of the cat, without bond, while any litigation is pending.
