

## MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2017 in the Municipal Office in the Rural Municipality of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan with all councillors present.

The meeting was called to order at 8:05 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2017 were approved as circulated, the Statements of Financial Activities for the month of October were accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council authorized gravel crushing, set the weighting of points in the scoring system used by the Ministry of Ag in allocating crown land lease applications within the municipality, authorized the renewals of benefits and insurance coverage, made the annual committee appointments, and set meeting dates and indemnity for 2017-2018. Council also authorized donations to the Bow Valley Villa and the SE Sask Stubble Jumpers and received three delegations.

Public Works Foreman, Andy Girard, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

A number of road right-of way applications were approved by council for wellsites, approaches, pipeline installations, and powerline installations.

Correspondence was received and filed.
