The virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel.


The readings for the 4th Sunday of Advent Year A challenge us to look beyond our own understanding and have faith. The first reading foretells that a virgin will give birth. The psalm praises the wonders of God. The second reading speaks of the promises of God through the ages and the resurrection of Jesus Christ. In the gospel we hear how an angel appeared to Joseph and he did as the angel told him.

#### Mass Readings for the 4th. Sunday of Advent

**First Reading** – Isaiah 7:10-14: "The LORD spoke to Ahaz, saying: 'Ask for a sign from the LORD, your God; let it be deep as the netherworld, or high as the sky!" **Responsorial Psalm** – Psalm 24: "Let the Lord enter; he is king of glory."

**Second Reading** – Romans 1:1-7: "The gospel is about his Son, descended from David according to the flesh, but established as Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness through resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord."

**Gospel** – Matthew 1:18-24: "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her."
