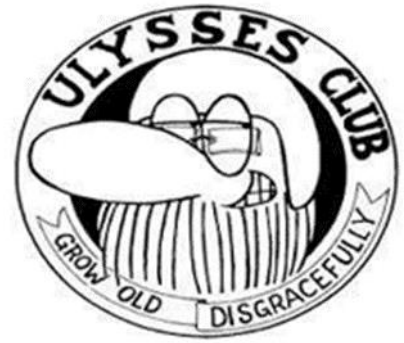

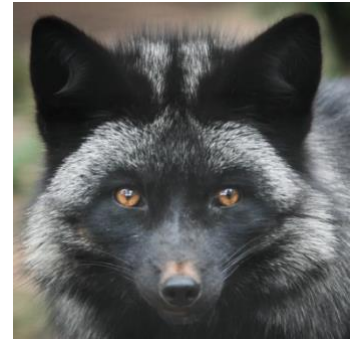

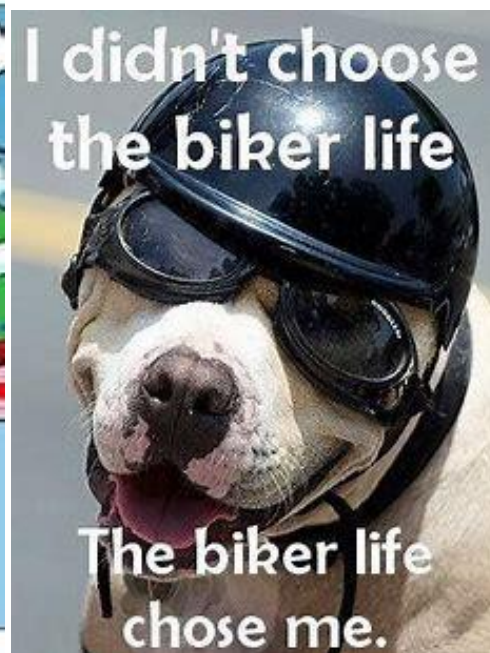

In our wide and diverse membership, you'll find many riders with a wide variety of motorcycles, and meet up with many interesting characters, from ex dirt and track racers, motorcycle mechanics, plumbers, and doctors to musicians, so there is always someone interesting to talk with.
