A Note From the Pastor

Truly Caring for Others

On April 9, 2020, Maundy Thursday, we will participate in a special worship experience where we will observe four actions Jesus shared with his disciples before his crucifixion. They are (1) confession and pardon, (2) proclamation of the Word, (3) foot washing, (4) the Lord's Supper. Most all of us are familiar with three of these four. Perhaps the one we are not so familiar with is that of foot washing. Rarely do we engage in this service. During this Maundy Thursday celebration my goal will be to help you understand how foot washing symbolizes and shows the care we need to have for each other.

John's Gospel chapter 13:1-17, 31b-35 is John's vision of communion, only this time acted out among human vulnerability. Jesus interrupts a shared meal with the disciples to wash the feet of his friends. When he pours water on the disciples' feet, Jesus displays a form of love that reorders social roles. Jesus, in this passage, takes the role of servant. He offers each disciple an act of hospitality.

Of course Peter is the disciple that constantly has to learn. He is the example for us as disciples today. It is easy for us to understand Peter's uneasiness with the loss of security that comes when Jesus kneels before him. Jesus' invitation into foot washing is not a momentary act of hospitality. For Jesus foot washing was a form of life rooted in the upheaval of society's expectations around leadership and status. I feel Jesus really wanted Peter to die to the myths of honor and power. For me, the real lesson from foot washing is that we need to be aware of all whom we can serve and do it. Only Jesus' sacrificial death on the cross can make sense of foot washing.

On April 9th we will have a foot washing in order to help us understand what it means. It is a powerful sacrament of renewed commitment to give and receive the parts of us that we want to hide from one another. Foot washing, like communion, is to receive an invitation into new life, new community, the firm foundation that extends from the cross into the eternity of God's great love.

Our congregation will be invited to participate. You may come to one of the stations as a family or if you are without family present may come to a station designated as such. Also please know that it is not required that you participate. This part of the service, as all parts, is based on your being led to participate.



Trinity UMC Scholarships


