The Million Mutt March is a rally and walk hosted by *No Kill Louisville*, a non-profit group working to change the approach to animal sheltering in Louisville. Those who founded *No Kill Louisville* believe it is possible to save every "adoptable" pet in our city.

Formed in April 2010, we have more than 8,000 people involved in our group and more than 30,000 supporters via social media. We connected with them at events, through social networking, on our website, and through word of mouth. We have met with city council members and the mayoral candidates about how to best become a No Kill community.

The Million Mutt March seeks to unite even more local animal lovers for this common cause: to change the approach to animal sheltering in our city and save thousands of companion pets every year.

On Sunday, October 12th, hundreds of people will walk (or run) through Cherokee Park with shelter dogs, in support of positive change that involves working together to find solutions to improve animal care in our city. Festivities for the event include vendors, various activities, food trucks, and live music.
