Latest Guidance for Communal Worship during the COVID 19 Pandemic

The date for reopening from lockdown is 19th July, although this is not confirmed.

The key measures, which churches and parishes have been carrying out, are to remain in place.

Hand sanitiser must continue to be used on entry to churches and before liturgies.

Please either scan in on the NHS Track & Trace or tick your name off the register.

<u>Please take one of the sheets</u> provided which must be left on the bench where you have been sitting. This is to ensure all the appropriate areas in church get sanitised after every service.

<u>At all times please adhere to the rules</u> of <u>SOCIAL DISTANCING</u> – sitting 1m apart in the church pews and the wearing of <u>FACE MASKS</u>. Please ensure that face coverings are worn properly, covering the nose, to reduce aerosol or droplet spread.

<u>Offertory collection at Mass</u> There are baskets at the entrance and exit from the church. Where possible, please use the contactless donation system. Payments can be made from a Stand in the church porch. <u>Physical exchange of a Sign of Peace</u> remains suspended.

<u>Holy Communion</u> is given in the hand only. Please wait in your pew until instructed to move forward. The communicant should have his/her arms outstretched to the full, palms facing upwards, one on top of the other. After unlooping the face covering the communicant consumes the Sacred Host at the sanctuary steps, replaces the face covering and moves back to the pew via one of the side aisles.
