Consideration and discussion of comments and complaints from the public. The Fire District Board is not permitted to discuss or take action on any item raised in the call to the public. However, individual Board members may be permitted to respond to criticism directed to them. Otherwise, the Board may direct that staff review the matter or that the matter be placed on a future agenda. The Fire District Board cannot discuss or take legal action on any issue raised during the Call to the Public due to restrictions of the Open Meeting Law.

- 6. Financial Report Chairman Turcotte gave an account balance of the districts two accounts. He discussed the closeout of the FEMA grant and the impact on the District. In addition he gave the results of tax collection as of Jan 14, 2022.

January 21 there will be a wildland training hosted with Winkelman fire with 5 volunteers attending. Application for tender through a grant was submitted.
