# Triplets in THE REVELATION

OF SAINT JOHN THE DIVINE

#### CHAPTER 1

- 1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to  $\frac{1}{\text{shew}}$  unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and  $\frac{2}{\text{he sent}}$  and  $\frac{3}{\text{signified}}$  it by his angel unto his servant John:
- 2 Who bare record of 1the word of God, and of 2the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of 3all things that he saw.
- 3 Blessed *is* he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time *is* at hand.
- 4 John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne;
- 5 And from Jesus Christ, who is <sup>1</sup>the faithful witness, and <sup>2</sup>the first begotten of the dead, and <sup>3</sup>the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that <sup>1</sup>loved us, and <sup>2</sup>washed us from our sins in his own blood,
- 6 And hath <sup>3</sup>made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him *be* glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.
- 7 Behold, he cometh with clouds; and <sup>1</sup>every eye shall see him, and <sup>2</sup>they also which pierced him: and <sup>3</sup>all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.
- 8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.
- 9 I John, who also <sup>1</sup>am your brother, and <sup>2</sup>companion in tribulation, and <sup>3</sup>in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.
- 10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,
  - 11 Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first

- 2 (John) bare record of <sup>1</sup>the word of God, <sup>2</sup>the testimony of Jesus Christ, <sup>3</sup>all things that he saw.
- 3 Blessed is he  $\frac{1}{1}$ that readeth,  $\frac{2}{1}$ that hear and  $\frac{3}{1}$ keep.
- 4 from him <sup>1</sup>which is, <sup>2</sup>which was, <sup>3</sup>which is to come;
- 5 Jesus Christ, who is 1the faithful witness, 2the first begotten of the dead, 3the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that 1loved us, and 2washed us
  - 6 3made us kings and priests
- 7 <sup>1</sup>every eye shall see him, and <sup>2</sup>they also which pierced him: and <sup>3</sup>all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him.
- 8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, the Almighty awhich is, bwhich was, which is to come,
- 9 I John, <sup>1</sup>am your brother, and <sup>2</sup>companion in tribulation, and (companion) <sup>3</sup>in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ,

- and the last: and, What thou <sup>1</sup>/<sub>seest</sub>, <sup>2</sup>write in a book, and <sup>3</sup>/<sub>send</sub> it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.
- 12 And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw <sup>1</sup>seven golden candlesticks;
- 13 And in the midst of the seven candlesticks *one* like unto <sup>2</sup>the Son of man, clothed with a <u>garment</u> down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden <u>girdle</u>.
- 14 <u>3His head and his hairs</u> were white like wool, as white as snow; and <u>4his eves</u> were as a flame of fire;
- 15 And shis feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and shis voice as the sound of many waters.
- 16 And he had in zhis right hand 3seven stars: and out of shis mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.
- 17 And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last:
- 18 <sup>2</sup>I am he that liveth, and was dead: and, behold, <sup>3</sup>I am alive for evermore. Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.
- 19 Write the <sup>1</sup>things which thou hast seen, and the <sup>2</sup>things which are, and the <sup>3</sup>things which shall be hereafter;
- 20 The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.

#### CHAPTER 2

- 1 Unto the angel of the church of Ephesus write; These things saith he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks;
- 2 I know <sup>1</sup>thy works, and <sup>2</sup>thy labour, and <sup>3</sup>thy patience, and how thou canst not bear them which are evil: and thou

- 11, What thou <sup>1</sup>seest, <sup>2</sup>write, <sup>3</sup>send
- 12, (I saw <sup>1</sup>seven golden candlesticks, vs.13,<sup>2</sup> the Son of Man, and vs.16, <sup>3</sup>seven stars)
- 13 (nine-3x3-items described vss 13-16, garment, girdle, head, eyes, feet, voice, hand, mouth, and countenance) a garment, girdle.
- 14 3His head (hair) and his hairs (beard), 4his eves
  - 15 5his feet, 6his voice
- 16  $\underline{_{7}}$ his right hand,  $\underline{_{8}}$ his mouth and  $\underline{_{9}}$ his countenance
  - 17 I AM the first and the last:
- 18 <sup>2</sup>I AM he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, <sup>3</sup>I AM alive for evermore,
- 19 Write the 1things which thou hast seen, 2things which are, 3things which shall be hereafter;

2 I know 1thy works, 2thy labour, 3thy patience,

- and thou <sup>1</sup><u>hast tried</u> them which say they are apostles, and are not, and <sup>2</sup><u>hast found</u> them liars:
- 3 And <sup>3</sup>hast borne, and <sup>4</sup>hast patience, and for my name's sake <sup>5</sup>hast laboured, and <sup>6</sup>hast not fainted.
- 4 Nevertheless I have *somewhat* against thee, because thou <sup>7</sup>hast left thy first love.
- 5 <u>Remember</u> therefore from whence thou art fallen, and <u>repent</u>, and <u>do</u> the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.
- **6** But this thou hast, that thou hatest the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.
- 7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.
- 8 And unto the angel of the church in Smyrna write; These things saith 1the first and the last, 2which was dead, and 3is alive;
- 9 I know the works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich) and I know the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan.
- 10 Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast *some* of you into <sup>1</sup>prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have <sup>2</sup>tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto <sup>3</sup>death, and I will give thee a crown of life.
- 11 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.
- 12 And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write; These things saith he which hath the sharp sword with two edges;
- 13 I know 1thy works, and 2where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is: 3 and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth.
- 14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the <sup>1</sup>doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, <sup>2</sup>to eat things sacrificed unto idols and to <sup>3</sup>commit fornication.

- (vss. 2-4 a list of seven "hast's" in three vss.)

  1 hast tried, 2 hast found
- 3 And 3hast borne, and 4hast patience, and 5hast laboured, and 6hast not fainted.
  - 4 <sup>7</sup>hast left thy first love.
- 5 Remember, repent, do (return to the first works)

- 8 These things saith <sup>1</sup>the first and the last, <sup>2</sup>which was dead, and <sup>3</sup>is alive;
- 9 I know  $\frac{^{1}$ thy works, and  $\frac{^{2}$ tribulation, and  $\frac{^{3}}$ poverty, I know the blasphemy of them  $\frac{^{1}$ which say and  $\frac{^{2}$ are not,  $\frac{^{3}$ but are
  - 10 Fear (not) <sup>1</sup>prison, <sup>2</sup>tribulation, <sup>3</sup>death,

- 13 I know 1thy works, where 2thou dwellest, and 3thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith,
- 14 (Satan's trinity of damnation, <sup>1</sup>false doctrine, <sup>1</sup>doctrine of Balaam, <sup>2</sup>feasting <sup>2</sup>to eat, and <sup>3</sup>fornication and to <sup>3</sup>commit fornication. see vs.20)

- 15 So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate.
- 16 Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth.
- 17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the <sup>1</sup>hidden manna, and will give him <sup>2</sup>a white stone, and in the stone <sup>3</sup>a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth *it*.
- **18** And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet *are* like fine brass;
- 19 I know  $\frac{1}{4}$ thy works, and  $\frac{2}{4}$ charity, and  $\frac{3}{4}$ service, and  $\frac{4}{4}$ faith, and thy  $\frac{5}{4}$ patience, and thy  $\frac{6}{4}$ works; and the last to be more than the first
- 20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, 1to teach and 2to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and 3to eat things sacrificed unto idols.
- **21** And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.
- 22 Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds.
- 23 And <sup>3</sup>I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which <sup>1</sup>searcheth the reins and <sup>2</sup>hearts: and I <sup>3</sup>will give unto every one of you according to your works.
- 24 But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden.
- 25 But that which ye have *already* hold fast till I come.
- 26 And he that <sup>2</sup>overcometh, and <sup>3</sup>keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over <sup>1</sup>the nations:
- 27 And he shall rule them with  $\frac{2}{\text{a rod}}$  of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.
  - 28 And I will give him 3the morning star.

17 will I give 1 hidden manna, 2 a white stone, 3 a new name.

# 19 I know (six things) 1thy works, 2charity, service, 4faith, 5thy patience, 6thy works;

- 20 (Satan's trinity of damnation repeated here as in vs. 14, <sup>1</sup>false doctrine, <sup>1</sup>to teach <sup>2</sup>feasting <sup>3</sup>to eat. and <sup>3</sup>fornication, <sup>2</sup>to seduce my servants to commit fornication, Three Satanic sources of false doctrine in six verses Vs. 14 doctrine of Balim, vs. 15 doctrine of Nicolaitans, vs. 20 doctrine of Jezebel)
- 22 Behold, I will <sup>1</sup>cast her into a bed, and <sup>2</sup>them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation,
- 23 And <sup>3</sup>I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I <sup>1</sup>searcheth the reins and <sup>2</sup>hearts: and I <sup>3</sup>will give unto every one of you according to your works.

**29** He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

#### **CHAPTER 3**

- 1 And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know <a href="https://linear.com/lthy.orks">1thy.orks</a>, that thou hast a <a href="mailto:2name">2name</a> that thou livest, and <a href="mailto:3art.dead">3art.dead</a>.
- 2 <u>Be watchful</u>, and <u>strengthen</u> the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works perfect before God.
- 3 3 Remember therefore 1 how thou hast received and heard, and 3 repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee.
- 4 Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with me in white: for they are worthy.
- 5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and 2 I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.
- **6** He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.
- 7 And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that <sup>1</sup>is holy, he that <sup>2</sup>is true, he that <sup>3</sup>hath the key of David, he that <sup>4</sup>openeth, and <sup>5</sup>no man shutteth; and <sup>6</sup>shutteth, and <sup>7</sup>no man openeth;
- 8 I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for 1thou hast a little strength, and 2hast kept my word, and 3hast not denied my name.
- 9 Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which 1sav thev are 1ews, and 2are not, but 3do lie; behold, I will make them to 1come and 2worship before thy feet, and to 3know that I have loved thee.
- 10 Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.
- 11 Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.

- 1 I know 1thy works, (thy) 2name, (thy state) 3art dead.
  - 2 Be watchful, 2strengthen
- 3 3 Remember, (remember) 1 how thou hast received and heard, 2 hold fast, and 3 repent.
- 4 have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with me in white: for are worthy.
- 5 He that overcometh, shall be \( \frac{1}{\text{clothed in}} \) white raiment; \( \frac{2}{\text{I will not blot out his name,}} \) I will confess his name
- 7 These things saith he that (list of seven)  $\frac{1}{1}$ is holy,  $\frac{2}{1}$ is true,  $\frac{3}{1}$ hath the key, he that  $\frac{4}{1}$ openeth, and  $\frac{5}{1}$ no man shutteth; and  $\frac{6}{1}$ shutteth, and  $\frac{7}{1}$ no man openeth;
- 8 1thou hast a little strength, (more than most) and 2hast kept my word, and 3hast not denied my name.
- 9  $\frac{1}{\text{say they are Jews}}$ , and  $\frac{2}{\text{are not}}$ , but  $\frac{3}{\text{do}}$   $\underline{\text{lie}}$ ; I will make them to  $\frac{1}{\text{come}}$  and  $\frac{2}{\text{worship}}$ , and to  $\frac{3}{\text{know}}$

- 12 Him that overcometh will <sup>1</sup>I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and <sup>2</sup>he shall go no more out: and <sup>3</sup>I will write upon him <sup>1</sup>the name of my God, and <sup>2</sup>the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him <sup>3</sup>my new name.
- 13 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.
- 14 And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith  $\frac{^{1}\text{the}}{^{3}\text{the}}$  Amen,  $\frac{^{2}\text{the faithful and true witness}}{^{3}\text{the beginning of the creation of God}}$ ;
- 15 I know 1thy works, that 2thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.
- 16 So then because <sup>3</sup>thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.
- 17 Because thou sayest, <sup>1</sup>I am rich, and <sup>2</sup>increased with goods, and <sup>3</sup>have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:
- 18 I counsel thee to buy of me <sup>1</sup>gold tried in the fire, <sup>A</sup>that thou mayest be rich; and <sup>2</sup>white raiment, that <sup>B</sup>thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with <sup>3</sup>eyesalve, <sup>C</sup>that thou mayest see.
- 19 As many as <sup>1</sup>I love, <sup>2</sup>I rebuke and <sup>3</sup>chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.
- 20 Behold, <sup>1</sup>I stand at the door, and <sup>2</sup>knock: if any man <sup>a</sup>hear my voice and <sup>b</sup>open the door, <sup>4</sup>I will come in to him, and <sup>c</sup>will sup with him, and he with me.
- 21 To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.
- **22** He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

#### **CHAPTER 4**

1 After this 1 looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which 2 heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither,

- 12 I make a pillar he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him (he writes upon them three names) the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, my new name.
- 14 <sup>1</sup>the Amen, <sup>2</sup>the faithful and true witness, <sup>3</sup>the beginning (the creator) of the creation of God;
- 15 I know the works, that the art neither cold nor hot:
  - 16 3thou art lukewarm,
- 17 Because thou sayest, <sup>1</sup>I am rich, and <sup>2</sup>increased with goods, and <sup>3</sup>have need of nothing:
- 18 (buy of me  $\frac{1}{\text{gold}}$ ,  $\frac{2}{\text{raiment}}$ , and  $\frac{3}{\text{evesalve}}$  so that thou mayest be  $\frac{A}{\text{rich}}$ , be  $\frac{B}{\text{clothed}}$ , and  $\frac{C}{\text{see}}$ )
- 19 As many as <sup>1</sup>I love, <sup>2</sup>I rebuke and <sup>3</sup>chasten:
- **20** (list of seven- [Jesus says] I stand, I knock, I call [hear my voice], I come in [the any man] hears, opens, sups)

#### **CHAPTER 4 TRIPLETS**

1 After this <sup>1</sup>I looked, <sup>2</sup>I heard

- **2** And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a Athrone was set in heaven, and *one* sat on the throne.
- 3 And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.
- 4 And round about the throne were <sup>1</sup>four and twenty <sup>B</sup>seats: and upon the seats I saw <sup>2</sup>four and twenty <sup>C</sup>elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads <sup>D</sup> crowns of gold.
- 5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and there were seven Flamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.
- **6** And before the throne *there was* a Fsea of glass like unto crystal: and in the midst of the throne, and round about the throne, were Gfour beasts full of eyes before and behind.
- 7 And the first beast *was* like a  $\frac{1 \text{lion}}{1 \text{lion}}$ , and the second beast like a  $\frac{2 \text{calf}}{1 \text{calf}}$ , and the third beast had a face as a  $\frac{3 \text{man}}{1 \text{calf}}$ , and the fourth beast *was* like a flying  $\frac{4 \text{calfe}}{1 \text{calff}}$ .
- 8 And the four beasts had each of them six 5wings about him; and they were full of 6eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, 1Holy, 2holy, 3holy, 1Lord 2God 3Almighty, 1which was, 2and is, and 3is to come.
- 9 And when **those beasts give** <sup>1</sup>glory and <sup>2</sup>honour and <sup>3</sup>thanks to him that sat on the throne, who liveth for ever and ever,
- 10 The four and twenty elders \( \frac{1}{\text{fall down}} \)
  before him that sat on the throne, and \( \frac{2}{\text{worship}} \) him that liveth for ever and ever, and \( \frac{3}{\text{cast their crowns}} \) before the throne, saying,
- 11 Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive <sup>1</sup>glory and <sup>2</sup>honour and <sup>3</sup>power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

#### **CHAPTER 5**

1 And I saw in  $\frac{^{1}$ the right hand of him that sat on the throne a  $\frac{^{2}$ book written  $\frac{^{A}$ within and on the  $\frac{^{B}$ backside,  $\frac{^{C}}$ sealed with seven seals.

- 2 And immediately <sup>3</sup>(I left) I was in the spirit:
- (a list of seven described in verses 2-6, A-G Throne, seats, Elders, crowns, lamps, sea of glass, and four beasts)a Athrone
- 3 And he that sat was to look upon  $\frac{1}{\text{like a}}$   $\frac{1}{\text{jasper}}$ , a  $\frac{2}{\text{sardine stone}}$ : and  $\frac{3}{\text{an emerald}}$ .
- 4 And round about the throne were and twenty Seats:, four and twenty clders four and twenty. To crowns of gold.
- $\frac{1}{\text{lightnings}}$  and  $\frac{2}{\text{thunderings}}$  and  $\frac{3}{\text{voices}}$ : and there were seven  $\frac{E_{\text{lamps}}}{\text{lamps}}$ 
  - 6 a Fsea of glass, Gfour beasts
- 7 (six fold description of beast) was like a <sup>1</sup>lion, <sup>2</sup>calf, <sup>3</sup>man, like a flying <sup>4</sup>eagle.
- 8 six <sup>5</sup>wings, <sup>6</sup>eyes within: saying <sup>1</sup>Holy, <sup>2</sup>holy, <sup>3</sup>holy, <sup>1</sup>Lord <sup>2</sup>God <sup>3</sup>Almighty, <sup>1</sup>which was, <sup>2</sup>and is, and <sup>3</sup>is to come.
- 9 those beasts give <sup>1</sup>glory and <sup>2</sup>honour and <sup>3</sup>thanks
- 10 The four and twenty elders <sup>1</sup>fall down, <sup>2</sup>worship, and <sup>3</sup>cast their crowns
- 11 to receive  $\frac{1}{2}$  glory and  $\frac{2}{1}$  honour and  $\frac{3}{2}$  power:

# **CHAPTER 5 TRIPLETS**

1 And I saw in the right hand, a book, (vs 2) sa strong angel (the book was written A-C, - within, on backside, and sealed) within and on the backside, C sealed with seven seals.

- 2 And I saw <sup>3</sup>a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?
- 3 And no man in <sup>1</sup>heaven, nor in <sup>2</sup>earth, neither <sup>3</sup>under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.
- 4 And I wept much, because **no man was found worthy**  $\frac{1}{\text{to open}}$  and  $\frac{2}{\text{to read}}$  the book, neither  $\frac{3}{\text{to look}}$  thereon.
- 5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: **behold**, the <sup>1</sup>Lion of the tribe of Juda, the <sup>2</sup>Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.
- **6** And **I beheld**, and, lo, in the midst of the athrone and of the beasts, and in the midst of the celders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth
- 7 And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.

Chapter 6 is the only chapter I found not to have a natural triplet but there are a lot of sixes representes. The Lamb opens six of the seven seals in chapter six. The book Revelation is the Sixty Sixth book of the bible and in the Sixth chapter find the first we appearance in Revelation of Satan incarnate - the Antichrist - old 666 himself..

- 12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood:

- 8 Of the tribe of <sup>1</sup>Zabulon were sealed <sup>a</sup>twelve thousand. Of the tribe of <sup>2</sup>Joseph were sealed <sup>b</sup>twelve thousand. Of the tribe of <sup>3</sup>Benjamin were sealed <sup>c</sup>twelve thousand.

- 11 And the beast that  $\frac{1}{\text{was}}$ , and  $\frac{2}{\text{is not}}$ , even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and  $\frac{3}{\text{goeth into perdition.}}$
- 12 And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast.
- 13 These have  $\frac{1}{2}$  one mind, and shall give their  $\frac{2}{2}$  power and  $\frac{3}{2}$  strength unto the beast.
- 14 These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful.

- 22 And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it
- **23** And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb *is* the light thereof.
- 24 And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it
- **25** And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there.

#### **CHAPTER 22 TRIPLETS**
