

Triplets in THE REVELATION

OF SAINT JOHN THE DIVINE

CHAPTER 1

1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to ¹shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and ²he sent and ³signified it by his angel unto his servant John:

2 Who bare record of ¹the word of God, and of ²the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of ³all things that he saw.

3 Blessed is he ¹that readeth, and they ²that hear the words of this prophecy, and ³keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.

4 John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from him ¹which is, and ²which was, and ³which is to come; and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne;

5 And from Jesus Christ, who is ¹the faithful witness, and ²the first begotten of the dead, and ³the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that ¹loved us, and ²washed us from our sins in his own blood,

6 And hath ³made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him *be* glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

7 Behold, he cometh with clouds; and ¹every eye shall see him, and ²they also which pierced him; and ³all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

8 ¹I am Alpha and Omega, ²the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, ³which is, and which was, and which is to come, ³the Almighty.

9 I John, who also ¹am your brother, and ²companion in tribulation, and ³in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.

10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,

11 Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first

7 ¹every eye shall see him, and ²they also which pierced him; and ³all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him.

8 ¹I am Alpha and Omega, ²the beginning and the ending, ³the Almighty ³which is, which was, which is to come,

9 I John, ¹am your brother, and ²companion in tribulation, and (*companion*) ³in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ,

and the last; and, What thou ¹seest, ²write in a book, and ³send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.

12 And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw ¹seven golden candlesticks:

13 And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto ²the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.

14 His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire;

15 And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters.

16 And he had in his right hand ³seven stars; and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.

17 And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; ¹I am the first and the last:

18 ²I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, ³I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

19 Write the ¹things which thou hast seen, and the ²things which are, and the ³things which shall be hereafter:

20 The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.

CHAPTER 2

1 Unto the angel of the church of Ephesus write; These things saith he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks;

2 I know ¹thy works, and ²thy labour, and ³thy patience, and how thou canst not bear them which are evil: and thou

11, What thou ¹seest, ²write, ³send

12, (*I saw ¹seven golden candlesticks, vs.13, ²the Son of Man, and vs.16, ³seven stars*)

13 (*nine-3x3-items described vss 13-16, garment, girdle, head, eyes, feet, voice, hand, mouth, and countenance*) a garment, girdle.

14 His head (*hair*) and his hairs (*beard*), his eyes

15 his feet, his voice

16 his right hand, his mouth and his countenance

17 ¹I AM the first and the last:

18 ²I AM he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, ³I AM alive for evermore,

19 Write the ¹things which thou hast seen, ²things which are, ³things which shall be hereafter:

2 I know ¹thy works, ²thy labour, ³thy patience,

and thou ¹hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and ²hast found them liars:

3 And ³hast borne, and ⁴hast patience, and for my name's sake ⁵hast laboured, and ⁶hast not fainted.

4 Nevertheless I have *somewhat* against thee, because thou ⁷hast left thy first love.

5 ¹Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and ²repent, and ³do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.

6 But this thou hast, that thou hatest the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.

7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

8 And unto the angel of the church in Smyrna write; These things saith ¹the first and the last, which was dead, and is alive;

9 I know ¹thy works, and ²tribulation, and ³poverty, (but thou art rich) and I know the blasphemy of them ¹which say they are Jews, and ²are not, ³but are the synagogue of Satan.

10 Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast *some* of you into ¹prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have ²tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto ³death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

11 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.

12 And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write; These things saith he which hath the sharp sword with two edges;

13 I know ¹thy works, and ²where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is: ³and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth.

14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the ¹doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, ²to eat things sacrificed unto idols and to ³commit fornication.

(vss. 2-4 a list of seven "hast's" in three vss.)

¹hast tried, ²hast found

3 And ³hast borne, and ⁴hast patience, and ⁵hast laboured, and ⁶hast not fainted.

4 ⁷hast left thy first love.

5 ¹Remember, ²repent, ³do (return to the first works)

8 These things saith ¹the first and the last, which was dead, and is alive;

9 I know ¹thy works, and ²tribulation, and ³poverty, I know the blasphemy of them ¹which say and ²are not, ³but are

10 Fear (not) ¹prison, ²tribulation, ³death,

13 I know ¹thy works, where ²thou dwellest, and ³thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith,

14 (Satan's trinity of damnation, ¹false doctrine, ¹doctrine of Balaam, ²feasting ²to eat, and ³fornication and to ³commit fornication. see vs.20)

REVELATION

15 So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate.

16 Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth.

17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the ¹hidden manna, and will give him ²a white stone, and in the stone ³a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.

18 And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet *are* like fine brass;

19 I know ¹thy works, and ²charity, and ³service, and ⁴faith, and thy ⁵patience, and thy ⁶works; and the last *to be* more than the first.

20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, ¹to teach and ²to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and ³to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

21 And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.

22 Behold, I will ¹cast her into a bed, and ²them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds.

23 And ³I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which ¹searcheth the reins and ²hearts; and I ³will give unto every one of you according to your works.

24 But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden.

25 But that which ye have *already* ¹hold fast till I come.

26 And he that ²overcometh, and ³keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over ¹the nations;

27 And he shall rule them with ²a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.

28 And I will give him ³the morning star.

17 will I give ¹hidden manna, ²a white stone, ³a new name.

19 I know (*six things*) ¹thy works, ²charity, ³service, ⁴faith, ⁵thy patience, ⁶thy works;

20 (*Satan's trinity of damnation repeated here as in vs. 14, ¹false doctrine, ¹to teach ²feasting ³to eat, and ³fornication, ²to seduce my servants to commit fornication. Three Satanic sources of false doctrine in six verses Vs. 14 doctrine of Balim, vs. 15 doctrine of Nicolaitans, vs. 20 doctrine of Jezebel*)

22 Behold, I will ¹cast her into a bed, and ²them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation.

23 And ³I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I ¹searcheth the reins and ²hearts; and I ³will give unto every one of you according to your works.

25 ¹hold fast

26 ²overcometh, and ³keepeth to him will I give ¹the nations;

27 ²a rod (*to rule*)

28 ³the morning star.

29 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

CHAPTER 3

1 And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know ¹thy works, that thou hast a ²name that thou livest, and ³art dead.

2 ¹Be watchful, and ²strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works perfect before God.

3 ³Remember therefore ¹how thou hast received and heard, and ²hold fast, and ³repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee.

4 Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which ¹have not defiled their garments; and they shall ²walk with me in white: for ³they are worthy.

5 He that overcometh, the same shall be ¹clothed in white raiment; and ²I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but ³I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

6 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

7 And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that ¹is holy, he that ²is true, he that ³hath the key of David, he that ⁴openeth, and ⁵no man shutteth; and ⁶shutteth, and ⁷no man openeth;

8 I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for ¹thou hast a little strength, and ²hast kept my word, and ³hast not denied my name.

9 Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which ¹say they are Jews, and ²are not, but ³do lie; behold, I will make them to ¹come and ²worship before thy feet, and to ³know that I have loved thee.

10 Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

11 Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.

CHAPTER 3 TRIPLETS

1 I know ¹thy works, (thy) ²name, (thy state) ³art dead.

2 ¹Be watchful, ²strengthen

3 ³Remember, (remember) ¹how thou hast received and heard, ²hold fast, and ³repent.

4 ¹have not defiled their garments; and ²they shall walk with me in white: for ³they are worthy.

5 He that overcometh, shall be ¹clothed in white raiment; ²I will not blot out his name, ³I will confess his name

7 These things saith he that (list of seven) ¹is holy, ²is true, ³hath the key, he that ⁴openeth, and ⁵no man shutteth; and ⁶shutteth, and ⁷no man openeth;

8 ¹thou hast a little strength, (more than most) and ²hast kept my word, and ³hast not denied my name.

9 ¹say they are Jews, and ²are not, but ³do lie; I will make them to ¹come and ²worship, and to ³know

12 Him that overcometh will ¹I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and ²he shall go no more out; and ³I will write upon him the name of my God, and ²the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him ³my new name.

13 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

14 And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith ¹the Amen, ²the faithful and true witness, ³the beginning of the creation of God:

15 I know ¹thy works, that ²thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.

16 So then because ³thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

17 Because thou sayest, ¹I am rich, and ²increased with goods, and ³have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

18 I counsel thee to buy of me ¹gold tried in the fire, ^Athat thou mayest be rich; and ²white raiment, that ^Bthou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with ³eyesalve, ^Cthat thou mayest see.

19 As many as ¹I love, ²I rebuke and ³chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.

20 Behold, ¹I stand at the door, and ²knock: if any man ^Ahear my voice and ^Bopen the door, ⁴I will come in to him, and ^Cwill sup with him, and he with me.

21 To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

22 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

CHAPTER 4

1 After this ¹I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which ²I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither,

12 ¹I make a pillar ²he shall go no more out: and ³I will write upon him (he writes upon them three names) ¹the name of my God, and ²the name of the city of my God, ³my new name.

14 ¹the Amen, ²the faithful and true witness, ³the beginning (the creator) of the creation of God:

15 I know ¹thy works, that ²thou art neither cold nor hot:

16 ³thou art lukewarm.

17 Because thou sayest, ¹I am rich, and ²increased with goods, and ³have need of nothing:

18 (buy of me ¹gold, ²raiment, and ³eyesalve so that thou mayest be ^Arich, be ^Bclothed, and ^Csee)

19 As many as ¹I love, ²I rebuke and ³chasten:

20 (list of seven- [Jesus says] I stand, I knock, I call [hear my voice], I come in – [the any man] - hears, opens, sups)

CHAPTER 4 TRIPLETS

1 After this ¹I looked, ²I heard

REVELATION

2 And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a ^Athrone was set in heaven, and *one* sat on the throne.

3 And he that sat was to look upon ¹like a jasper and a ²sardine stone: and *there was* a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto ³an emerald.

4 And round about the throne were ¹four and twenty ^Bseats: and upon the seats I saw ²four and twenty ^Celders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads ^Dcrowns of gold.

5 And out of the throne proceeded ¹lightnings and ²thunderings and ³voices: and *there were* seven ^Elamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

6 And before the throne *there was* a ^Fsea of glass like unto crystal: and in the midst of the throne, and round about the throne, were ^Gfour beasts full of eyes before and behind.

7 And the first beast *was* like a ¹lion, and the second beast like a ²calf, and the third beast had a face as a ³man, and the fourth beast *was* like a flying ⁴eagle.

8 And the four beasts had each of them six ⁵wings about *him*; and *they were* full of ⁶eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, ¹Holy, ²holy, ³holy, ¹Lord ²God ³Almighty, ¹which was, ²and is, and ³is to come.

9 And when *those beasts* give ¹glory and ²honour and ³thanks to him that sat on the throne, who liveth for ever and ever,

10 The four and twenty elders ¹fall down before him that sat on the throne, and ²worship him that liveth for ever and ever, and ³cast their crowns before the throne, saying,

11 Thou art worthy, O Lord, *to receive* ¹glory and ²honour and ³power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

CHAPTER 5

1 And I saw in ¹the right hand of him that sat on the throne a ²book written ^Awithin and on the ^Bbackside, ^Csealed with seven seals.

2 And immediately ³(I left) I was in the spirit:

(a list of seven described in verses 2-6, A-G Throne, seats, Elders, crowns, lamps, sea of glass, and four beasts) a ^Athrone

3 And he that sat was to look upon ¹like a jasper, a ²sardine stone: and ³an emerald.

4 And round about the throne were ¹four and twenty ^Bseats: ²four and twenty ^Celders ^(3 four and twenty) ^Dcrowns of gold.

5 And out of the throne proceeded ¹lightnings and ²thunderings and ³voices: and *there were* seven ^Elamps

6 a ^Fsea of glass, ^Gfour beasts

7 *(six fold description of beast)* *was* like a ¹lion, ²calf, ³man, like a flying ⁴eagle.

8 six ⁵wings, ⁶eyes within: saying ¹Holy, ²holy, ³holy, ¹Lord ²God ³Almighty, ¹which was, ²and is, and ³is to come.

9 *those beasts* give ¹glory and ²honour and ³thanks

10 The four and twenty elders ¹fall down, ²worship, and ³cast their crowns

11 *to receive* ¹glory and ²honour and ³power:

CHAPTER 5 TRIPLETS

1 And I saw in ¹the right hand ,a ²book,
(vs 2) ³a strong angel *(the book was written A-C, - within, on backside, and sealed)* ^Awithin and on the ^Bbackside, ^Csealed with seven seals.

REVELATION

2 And I saw ³a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?

3 And no man in ¹heaven, nor in ²earth, neither ³under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.

4 And I wept much, because **no man was found worthy ¹to open and ²to read** the book, neither ³to look thereon.

5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: **behold**, the ¹Lion of the tribe of Juda, the ²Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

6 And **I beheld**, and, lo, in the midst of the ^athrone and of the ^bfour beasts, and in the midst of the ^celders, stood a ³Lamb^d as it had been slain, having ^eseven horns and ^fseven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth

7 And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.

8 And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four *and* twenty **elders** fell down before the Lamb, **having** every one of them ¹harps, and golden ²vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints.

9 And they sung a ³new song, saying, **Thou art worthy to ¹take the book, and ²to open the seals** thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast ³redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

10 And **hast made us** unto our God ¹kings and ²priests: and ³we shall reign on the earth.

11 And I beheld, and **I heard the voice** of many ¹angels round about the throne and the ²beasts and the ³elders: and the number of them was ¹ten thousand times ²ten thousand, and ³thousands of thousands;

12 Saying with a loud voice, **Worthy is the Lamb** that was slain **to receive ¹power, and ²riches, and ³wisdom, and ⁴strength, and ⁵honour, and ⁶glory, and ⁷blessing.**

13 And **every creature** which is in ¹heaven, and on the ²earth, and ³under the earth, and such as are ⁴in the sea, and ⁵all that are in them, heard I saying, ⁶Blessing, and ⁷honour, and ⁸glory, and ⁹power, *be* unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.

14 And the ¹four beasts said, Amen. And the ²four and twenty elders fell down

3 And no man in ¹heaven, nor in ²earth, neither ³under the earth,

4 **no man was found worthy ¹to open and ²to read, ³to look** thereon.

5 **behold**, the ¹Lion, the ²Root, (*vs. 6*) the ³Lamb

6 (*vs Six has Six items A-G, And I beheld,* ^athrone ^bfour beasts, ^celders, ^{d,3}Lamb, ^eseven horns and ^fseven eyes,

8 **elders having** (*they had*) ¹harps, and golden ²vials

9, a ³new song, saying, **Thou art worthy to ¹take the book, and ²to open the seals ³redeemed us to God**

10 **hast made us ¹kings and ²priests:** and ³we shall reign (*rulers*).

11 **I heard the voice** of ¹angels, ²beasts and ³elders: and the number of them was ¹ten thousand times ²ten thousand, and ³thousands of thousands;

12 **Worthy is the Lamb to receive** (*list of seven*) ¹power, ²riches, ³wisdom, ⁴strength, ⁵honour, ⁶glory, and ⁷blessing.

13 And **every creature** which is (*3-3's*) in ¹heaven, ²earth, and ³under the earth, ⁴in the sea, and ⁵all that are in them, saying, ⁶Blessing, and ⁷honour, and ⁸glory, and ⁹power,

14 And the ¹four beasts said, Amen. And the ²four and twenty elders fell down and

³worshipped him that liveth for ever and ever.

CHAPTER 6

1 And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.

2 And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.

3 And when he had opened the second seal, I heard the second beast say, Come and see.

4 And there went out another horse *that was* red: and *power* was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword.

5 And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.

6 And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and *see* thou hurt not the oil and the wine.

7 And when he had opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth beast say, Come and see.

8 And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.

9 And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:

10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?

11 And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they *were*, should be fulfilled.

*Chapter 6 is the only chapter I found **not to have** a natural triplet but there are a lot of sixes representes. The Lamb opens **six** of the seven seals in chapter **six**. The book of Revelation is the **Sixty Sixth** book of the bible and in the **Sixth** chapter we find the first appearance in Revelation of Satan incarnate - the Antichrist - old **666** himself..*

REVELATION

12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;

13 And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.

14 And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.

15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;

16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

17 For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?

CHAPTER 7

6 And I saw another ¹angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people,

13 And I saw **three unclean spirits** like frogs *come* out of the ¹mouth of the dragon, and out of the ²mouth of the beast, and out of ³the mouth of the false prophet.

14 For **they are the spirits of devils**, ¹working miracles, *which* ²go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, ³to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

7 How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously, so much ¹torment and ²sorrow give her: for she saith in her heart, ^AI sit a queen, and ^Bam no widow, and ^Cshall see no sorrow.

8 Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, ³death, and ⁴mourning, and ⁵famine; and she shall be utterly ⁶burned with fire: for strong *is* the Lord God who judgeth her.

9 And the kings of the earth, who have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her, ¹shall bewail her, and ²lament for her, when they ³shall see the smoke of her burning.

10 ¹Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, ²saying, Alas, alas, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for in one hour is ³thy judgment come.

11 And the merchants of the earth ¹shall weep and mourn over her; for no man buyeth their merchandise any more:

17 For in one hour so great riches is come to nought. And every shipmaster, and all the company in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, stood afar off,

18 And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, What *city* is like unto this great city!

19 And they ¹cast dust on their heads, and cried, ²weeping and wailing, ³saying, Alas, alas, that great city, wherein were made rich all that had ships in the sea by reason of her costliness! for in one hour is she made desolate.

20 Rejoice over her, *thou* ¹heaven, and ye ²holy apostles and ³prophets; for God hath avenged you on her.

21 And a mighty angel ¹took up a stone like a great millstone, and ²cast it into the sea, ³saying, Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.

22 And the voice of harpers, and musicians, and of pipers, and trumpeters, shall be heard no more at all in thee; and no craftsman, of whatsoever craft *he be,* shall be found any more in thee; and the sound of a millstone shall be heard no more at all in thee;

23 And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in thee; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in thee: for thy merchants were the great men of the earth; for by thy sorceries were all nations deceived.

11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him *was* called ¹Faithful and ²True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

8 And shall go out to deceive the ¹nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, ²Gog and ³Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom *is* as the sand of the sea.

9 And they ¹went up on the breadth of the earth, and ²compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and ³devoured them.

8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

9 And there came unto me one of the ¹seven angels which had the ²seven vials full of the ³seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife.

10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

11 Having the glory of God: and her light was like unto ¹a stone most precious, even like ²a jasper stone, ³clear as crystal;

12 And had a wall ^agreat and ^bhigh, and ^chad ¹twelve gates, and at the gates ²twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are the names of the ³twelve tribes of the children of Israel:

13 On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates.

14 And the wall of the city had ²twelve foundations, and in them the names of the ³twelve apostles of the Lamb.

15 And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the ¹city, and the ²gates

23 And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.

24 And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.

25 And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there.

26 And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it.

27 And there shall in **no wise** enter into it ¹any thing that defileth, neither *whatsoever* ²worketh abomination, or ³maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.
