- **No patrons will be allowed on the track or field for any reason, including photography, during the ceremony. Photos may be taken after the ceremony.**
- Only the diploma cover will be presented at the ceremony. At the conclusion of the ceremony, students will return to the same place they picked up their name cards to get their diplomas. Please pick up diplomas immediately following the graduation ceremony, before taking photos.
- **10:00pm Graduation All Night Party: Project Graduation**
 - a. At Murray High School (10:00pm - 5:00am)
 - b. Ticket price (\$30.00 advance \$35.00 at the door) includes food, prizes, all facilities and games.
