# MONTHLY COMMITTEE MEETING


Our next committee meeting is scheduled for **Tuesday 15th November** starting from 7:30pm at the Clubhouse.


## UNDER PAR COUNT



## 2022 MALE CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS REVIEW

Against the odds, our 2022 Club Championship was able to be completed as originally scheduled throughout October with Champions crowned across the 3 Grades.


The course improved across the 3 weeks, however, not quite enough to get carts back on which only allowed for walking golfers to compete.

Our overall **2022 Club Champion** & **A-Grade** (0-13) Gross & Winner was taken out by David Curry who carded rounds of 75, 75 & 73 Gross over the 3 weeks totally 223 & 202 Nett. David edged out Jordan Wilkinson on the final day by 2 shots.

**B-Grade** (14-18) Gross & Nett was claimed by Graeme Valentine who took the lead early in Round 1 & continued to card impressive scores including a Final Round of 64 Nett to claim the Tom Goodman Trophy after getting his hands on a monthly medal in round 1. Graeme's rounds of 79, 81 & 78 totalled 238 Gross & 196 Nett which put him in 1st position with Robert Richardson next best at 255.

**C-Grade** was contested with a match play feel heading into the Final Round with only 2 players available to compete in week 3. Nick Howell triumphed as both Champion & Nett winner with his best card of 89 in the final round after starting with 93 & 95 in rounds 1 & 2 leaving him with a grand total of 277 & 208 Nett. Nick claimed the title over Michael Shanley with a 12 shot lead.

## AVERAGE DRIVING DISTANCES

with Golf Digest

Golfers are really bad at evaluating their own abilities, especially in one specific area: The distance they hit the ball. Time and time again golfers overestimate how far they hit their ball from tee-to-green. It causes them to come up short, which makes golf more difficult and less fun.

In some ways, it doesn't matter how far you hit the ball, only that you know how far you hit the ball. So, in the humbling pursuit of truth, let's look at some Arccos data to see how far you need to hit your driver to be considered average.

These numbers from Arccos align quite closely to the data the USGA released as part of its distance report last year. And if the distances are shorter than you expect—well, that's sort of the point. Sure, your good drive might travel further than any of these, but remember that these are averages. A good drive might go further, but a topped drive, or a duck hook into the trees, needs to be factored in too.

Playing the distance on your best swings is what causes golfers to come up short so often.

It's playing to your averages, however humbling they may be, that will help your score at the end of it.


