- In this class, we are going to discover a few things about ourselves and about life.
- We are going to lay the groundwork for answering some burning questions that can change the course of our lives.

Questions that each one of us has contemplated:

What is my purpose? I know I have potential, how do I fulfill my greatest potential? What are my abilities, gifts and talents? What does success look like in my life? What are some challenges to fulfilling my purpose?

But the first question we will explore is: Who am I? / What is my identity?

When we meet someone, one of the first questions we ask is "what do you do, what's your role?"

These are many categories we use to define ourselves and that others use to tell us our worth. But, last but not least, the only identifier that really matters: **Your identity in Christ.**

The Truth

"For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so that we can do good things He planned for us long ago" Ephesians 2:10

Believe it or not—no one else is just like you. Your physical appearance, your voice and personality traits—your habits, intelligence, personal tastes—all these make you one of a kind. You are not the product of some cosmic assembly line; you are unique. You may not feel like a masterpiece. There are times when we feel anything but! But the Lord wants us to know how much He loves us and that He is with us even in times of despair.

Before architects design any new building they first ask, "What will be its purpose? How will it be used?" The intended function always determines the form of the building.

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. **Ephesians 2:10**

But even the hairs of your head are all numbered. Matthew 10:30

Even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him in love **Ephesians 1:4**

There are those who have this totally in reverse. They think that God should cater to our every need and provide us with all of our desires. But God has made us for His glory and to serve Him.
