Wishing You a Merry Christmas!

Hello, Friends,

I know you're probably saying, "Sister Katherine, you're late. Why are you wishing me a Merry Christmas the day *after* Christmas?"

Through the timing of this letter, God is showing us that Christmas is not something to be celebrated one day, one month, or even one season of the year. Christmas is to be celebrated all year long. As we approach the new year, I want to take a few moments to encourage you to keep the celebration going. But in order to keep the celebration going, we must first know what we are celebrating.

If we look at the word Christmas, we see that it is broken into two parts:

Christ + mas

Did you know that Christ is not Jesus' last name? The New Testament word "Christ" means the same thing as the Old Testament word "Messiah." They both mean "The Anointed One and His Anointing." With this in mind, what are we celebrating when we celebrate CHRISTmas?

Christ: The Anointed One and His Anointing

Mas: Celebration

Christmas = Celebration of the Anointed One and His Anointing

This is a celebration that can go on all day, every day, every day of the year!

Look with me at a popular Christmas verse, Luke 2:11:

For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.

Many tend to celebrate the birth of Jesus, as we should. Many tend to celebrate Jesus, the Savior of the world, as we should. But many times, that is where the celebration ends. If we look at Luke 2:11 closely, we will see that the Saviour that was born is **Christ** the Lord.

Christ: The Anointed One and His Anointing.

Where is Christ now? Colossians 1:27 tells us where He is: ... Christ <u>in you</u>, the hope of glory.

The Anointing

For everyone who has received Jesus, we have a superpower on the inside of us. It's called The Anointing - the same anointing that Jesus had when He was on earth. For indeed, Christ, the Anointed One and His Anointing, lives inside us.

Some might think it is sacrilegious to say that we have the same anointing as Jesus. Well, let's look at it:

Acts 10:38 says, "How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power Who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with Him." This is the same Holy Ghost and power spoken of in Acts 1:8: "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me...." The same Holy Spirit that God anointed Jesus with is the same Holy Spirit that comes to indwell us when we receive Jesus and the same Holy Spirit that empowers us to live the life that Jesus came to give us and to do the work that God has given us to do.

Not only are we anointed with the same Holy Spirit Jesus was anointed with, but we can receive the Holy Spirit to the same measure as Jesus received Him. **John 3:34** tells us, speaking of Jesus, "For He whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto Him." The Amplified Classic translation says, "...God does not give Him His Spirit sparingly or by measure, but boundless is the gift God makes of His Spirit!" Jesus, speaking of us, says in **John 17:18**, "As Thou hast sent Me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world." Therefore, John 3:34 doesn't just refer to Jesus. It refers to us as well.

Now that we know what Jesus was anointed with, what was He anointed to do?

As we read in **Acts 10:38**, Jesus was anointed to "[go] about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil." In **Luke 4:18-19**, Jesus proclaimed that God anointed Him to preach the gospel to the poor, heal the brokenhearted, preach deliverance to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, set at liberty them that are bruised, and preach the acceptable year of the Lord. And guess what! Everything Jesus did, we can do! Jesus tells us in **John 14:12**, "He that believeth on Me, *the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do....*" Receive that by faith.

So the question becomes, If we are anointed with the same Holy Ghost as Jesus was anointed with and we can have the Holy Spirit without measure as Jesus had the Holy Spirit without measure, how do we walk in the anointing as Jesus walked in the anointing?

Great question!

Walking in the Anointing

To walk in the anointing, we must cooperate with the anointing. We cooperate with the anointing by doing what Jesus instructs us to do. Let's return to our Christmas scripture, **Luke 2:11**:

...Owning and Celebrating our Identity in Christ and Influencing Others to do the Same!



For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is <u>Christ the Lord</u>.

Many, when they receive Jesus, receive Him as Savior – the One Who died for their sins and rose on the third day, but do not make Him their Lord. Therefore, they do not experience His salvation or His anointing. **Romans 10:9** tells us, "That *if thou shalt confess* with thy mouth *the Lord Jesus*, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, *thou shalt be saved*." In other words, when you make Jesus your Lord, He will automatically become your Savior. Why? Because when you make Jesus your Lord, you will do what He says. When you do what He says, you will get His results (i.e., salvation, which includes deliverance, protection, wholeness, prosperity, help, peace, joy, love, etc.) and you will engage His anointing that is upon your life.

Jesus tells us in **John 14:12-14** (Message Translation) that, "The person who trusts Me will not only do what I'm doing but even greater things, because I, on My way to the Father, am giving you the same work to do that I've been doing. You can count on it. From now on, whatever you request along the lines of Who I am and what I am doing, I'll do it. That's how the Father will be seen for Who He is in the Son. I mean it. Whatever you request in this way, I'll do." When we do things His way – in line with Who He is and what He is doing, He will make sure it happens. That is how we walk in the anointing!

Have You Made Jesus Your Lord? (The Litmus Test)

Have you made Jesus your Lord? I'm not asking you if you're saved. The answer does not lie in whether you believe in God or if you've prayed the "sinner's prayer" or how long you've been going to church or even how long you've been in ministry. The answer lies in your response to this question:


Is Jesus saying this to you? *And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?* (Luke 6:46). (To read more, request my ebook, "Jesus Is Lord, But Is He *Yours?*")

We cannot walk in the anointing without cooperating with the anointing. We cooperate with the anointing by making Jesus our Lord, which means we listen to Him and doing what He says.¹

Every born-again Believer has Christ - the Anointed One and His Anointing - living on the inside of him or her. Every *Spirit-filled Believer*² has the ability to walk in the anointing as Jesus walked in the anointing. **Acts 10:38** in the Amplified Classic translation says, "How God anointed and consecrated Jesus of Nazareth with the [Holy] Spirit *and with strength and ability and power....*" We are anointed with this same strength, ability, and power. We have power through God's ability just as Jesus did when He walked the earth.

Keep the Celebration Going!

We don't have Christ, the Anointed One and His Anointing on the inside of us just one day, month, or season out of the year. We have Him inside of us every moment of every day. God's Word says that He never leaves us or forsakes us (Heb. 13:5), and Jesus Christ (*the Anointed One and His Anointing*) the same yesterday, today, and forever (Heb. 13:8).

So, as we close out this traditional Christmas season, let's keep the Christmas celebration going - the celebration of the Anointed One and His Anointing alive on the inside of us! Let's celebrate by walking in this anointing and allowing God to do His work through us just like He did through Jesus.

Amen? [Amen!]

If you have been blessed by what you have just read, **OR**, if you have been *challenged* by what you just read - I would like to encourage you to give, or to "sow on it." **Name your seed in faith and expect to receive a harvest of it in your life.** Just as you would plant corn seeds if you wanted to harvest corn, plant the seed you want to harvest. If you are believing God for your car note to be paid, name the seed "Car Note," sow it in faith, and expect to see the harvest of that seed (i.e., your car note being paid and something extra because the harvest is always greater than the seed). If you are believing for favor on your job, name the seed "Favor." If you are believing for healing in your body or salvation for a loved one, name your seed accordingly -whatever you are believing God for. I stand in agreement with you that God will grant your request according to His will, in Jesus' Name.

As you prepare to sow your next seed (sowing outlets are listed at the end of this letter), sow it in faith as demonstration that you believe you receive a harvest of this Word in your life. Be blessed knowing that I am praying for you and speaking <u>PERFECT VISION</u> to you, in Jesus' Name.


