1 Use Maths-Pro or Geo-Pro to draw any triangle.
(In the example below, the original triangle is shown in black).
2 Draw a square on each side of the triangle.
3 Join corners of squares as shown to from three more line segments.

4 Draw squares on these new segments.
5 Find the total area of the three inner squares.
6 Find the total area of the three outer squares.
7 Compare your last two answers.
8 Repeat for one or more different triangles.
